Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

Report Narrative: On 011116 at approximately 1627 hours, R/O responded to the Bensenville PD lobby for an Identity Theft report. Upon arrival, R/O met with Daniel Polak me [REDACTED] who stated the following in summary:

Daniel stated that in 2015 and 2016, he was applying for a government position on USjobs.gov. Approximately December 2015, Daniel was advised via email that USjobs.gov was compromised and all personal information, including name, social security number, address and birthday were stolen. Daniel stated that USjobs.gov offered 3 years of a credit protection service, Tri Bureau Credit Report and Monitoring, that he signed up for immediately.

On 01/09/16 Daniel was advised by the monitoring service that an unknown subject attempted to open a Victoria's Secret Credit card with his personal information. Daniel stated that the unknown subject used all his personal information except for a phone number which was used to apply for the card. Daniel stated that the credit card company, Comenity, stated that they were unable to provide the phone number given without a subpoena. Daniel advised Comenity that the application for the credit card was not made by him and Comenity stopped the process for the credit card.

Complaints will be signed if an offender is located.
