- 1) Village of Bensenville Call for Service Report No. BV16000702. (2 pgs.)


These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.

JOSE L. HERNANDEZ-VELEZ [REDACTED] CAME INTO BPD AND STATED HE WISHED TO HAVE AN OFFICER STAND-BY AS HE AND HIS SISTER PATRICIA AVILA-VELEZ F/W [REDACTED] REMOVED THEIR BELONGINGS FROM THE RESIDENCE. JOSE INFORMED R/O THAT THERE WAS AN ACTIVE OOP BANNING JOSE FROM THE RESIDENCE BUT THAT IN THEIR LAST COURT DATE HE AND THE PROTECTED PARTY PRISCILLA I. DIAZ-ZEPEDA F/W [REDACTED] HAD AGREED TO MEET AND THE RESIDENCE AND REMOVED THEIR BELONGINGS. R/O WENT TO THE RESIDENCE AND SPOKE WITH PRISCILLA AND ASKED HER IF SUCH ARREGEMENT HAD BEEN MADE. PRISCILLA STATED IT WAS. PRISCILLA AGREED TO ALLOW JOSE AND PATRICIA IN THE RESIDENCE AS R/O STOOD BY TO HAVE THE ITEMS REMOVED. PATRICIA REMOVED ALL OF HER BELONGINGS AND JOSE ALSO REMOVED HIS BELONGINGS WHICH HAD BEEN PACKED BY PRISCILLA PRIOR TO HIS ARRIVAL. ALL ITEMS REMOVED FROM THE RESIDENCE WERE APPROVED AND UNDISPUTED BY PRISCILLA. JOSE WAS REMINDED BY R/O THAT THE ORDER OF PROTECTION WAS STILL VALID AND ONCE HE AND R/O LEFT THE PREMISES HE WAS NOT ALLOWED TO RETURN AND HAVE ANY TYPE OF CONTACT WITH PRISCILLA.
