Dear Ms. Wylie:

I am pleased to help you with your February 5, 2016 Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"). Your request was received by the Village of Bensenville on February 10, 2016. You requested copies of the items indicated below:

*"161060 Vandalism."*

After a search of Village files, the following documents are enclosed to fulfill your request:

- 1) Village of Bensenville Crime Report No. BV16001060.1. (3 pgs.)

These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when complied without possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

Report Narrative On 020316 at approximately 1657 hours, R/O responded to the area of George and County Line Rd for a criminal damage to property to report that just occurred. Dispatch relayed that a male hispanic subject threw a bottle at the complainants vehicle and broke the window. R/O located the complainant, later identified as [REDACTED], on John St. R/O observed a white 2010 Acura TSX with a broken rear window and a broken rear driver's window. [REDACTED] described the following in summary:

[REDACTED] was headed north bound on County line Rd approaching George St in his Acura. [REDACTED] stated that he was headed west bound onto George St. [REDACTED] observed a vehicle in front of him, described as a white SUV in the midst of making the turn onto west bound George from north bound County Line Rd. [REDACTED] stated that the SUV was stopped mid-turn and waved [REDACTED] around. [REDACTED] noticed a hispanic male standing on the south west corner of George and County Line Rd, possibly talking to the driver of the white SUV, described as a female. [REDACTED] stated that he attempted to go around the vehicle but then the vehicle tried to move and continue north bound on to County Line [REDACTED] stated that he tapped his horn twice to alert the SUV that he was making the turn and to avoid an accident. After honking his horn, he heard something crash through his rear driver's side window. [REDACTED] stopped his vehicle and approached the hispanic male stating "What the fuck? I didn't do anything to you!" [REDACTED] stated that the male hispanic repeatedly yelled at him "What's up nigga! What's up nigga!". A female then jumped out of the white SUV and held back the male hispanic who appeared to be coming toward [REDACTED]. The female then yelled at [REDACTED] to get back in his car and leave. [REDACTED] went back into his vehicle and the hispanic male picked up another clear bottle and threw it through his rear window, causing it to break. [REDACTED] stated that he drove down the road and called police and continued to try to watch the male, but stated that the male hispanic and white SUV was gone.

[REDACTED] described the hispanic male as 5'9" in his 20's wearing a black hoodie with the hood up. [REDACTED] was unable to provide any other details on subjects or vehicles.

A search of the area was preformed by R/O and Ofc. Kotlewski with negative results.

[REDACTED] stated that he was willing to sign complaints if an offender was located.
