I am pleased to assist you with your February 17, 2016 Freedom of Information Act request for information ("FOIA Request"). You requested copies of the records indicated below:

"any and all information and an unredacted copy of a police report involving Luis A. Echevarria (DOB 2/16/1983) on or around 8/3/2002. Case number unknown"

Enclosed are all the Village records responsive to your FOIA Request. The Village has redacted information that is personal and private, including home address, personal e-mail, personal phone number, social security numbers and driver's license number information pursuant to Section 7(1)(b), 7(1)(c) and 2(c-5) of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/7, 140/2. The Village has also redacted the identities of persons who file complaints with or provide information to law enforcement in connection with a criminal matter and any information leading thereto under section 7(1)(d)(iv) of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(d)(iv).

The Village has also redacted Law Enforcement Agencies Data System ("LEADS") data that was communicated exclusively through the LEADS system. This information is strictly confidential pursuant to 5 ILCS 140/7(1) (a) and the Illinois Administrative Code, Title 20, Chapter 11, Part 1240.110. *See also, Better Government Ass'n v. Zaruba*, 2014 IL App (2d) 140071, 21 N.E.3d 516 (2d Dist. 2014).

Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

IN SUMMARY, ON 08-03-02 AT APPROXIMATELY 0515 HOURS THE R/O RESPONDED 640 S YORK RD. FOR THE REPORT OF A VEHICLE STRIKING OTHER CARS IN THE PARKING LOT.

UPON ARRIVAL, THE R/O SPOKE TO THE WITNESS, [REDACTED] WHO STATED THAT SHE OBSERVED THE DRIVER OF UNIT ONE EXIT THE APARTMENT BUILDING AT 640 S YORK RD. [REDACTED] STATED THAT SHE OBSERVED THE DRIVER OF UNIT ONE URINATE ON UNIT TWO BEFORE HE ENTERED UNIT ONE.

ON 08-03-02 AT APPROXIMATELY 0514 HOURS, R/O WAS DISPATCHED TO THE FAIRWAY GREENS APARTMENT BUILDING COMPLEX PARKING LOT (640-650 S. YORK ROAD) FOR THE REPORT OF A SUBJECT DRIVING A BEIGE CHRYSLER NEW YORKER BEARING ██████████ THAT HAD JUST STRUCK THREE PARKED VEHICLES, THE 640 S. YORK ROAD APARTMENT BUILDING, AND A TREE LOCATED ON THE PROPERTY (REFER TO B.P.D. ACCIDENT REPORT #02-9775 SUBMITTED BY OFFICER SMUSKIEWICZ #539).

UPON ARRIVAL R/O LOCATED THE STATED CHRYSLER NEW YORKER IN THE NORTH SECTION OF THE PARKING LOT FACING NORTHWEST IN A NORTH FACING PARKING SPACE WITH THE RIGHT DRIVER SIDE FRONT FENDER PINNED AGAINST THE PASSENGER SIDE BODY OF A BLACK NISSAN MAXIMA BEARING IL REG. ██████████ R/O APPROACHED THE VEHICLE AND OBSERVED THAT THE AUTOMATIC TRANSMISSION GEAR SELECT WAS IN THE REVERSE POSITION. R/O IMMEDIATELY PLACED THE VEHICLE IN PARK AND MADE CONTACT WITH THE DRIVER, LATER IDENTIFIED AS ██████████.

R/O ASKED ██████████ IF HE HAD STRUCK HIS HEAD OR WAS INJURED IN ANY WAY. ██████████ RESPONDED "NO" TO BOTH QUESTIONS. R/O THEN ASKED ██████████ FOR HIS DRIVER'S LICENSE AND PROOF OF VEHICLE INSURANCE. ██████████ RESPONDED THAT HE DID NOT HAVE A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR VEHICLE INSURANCE. DURING THE VERBAL EXCHANGE WITH ██████████ R/O WAS IMMEDIATELY ABLE TO DETECT A STRONG ODOR OF AN ALCOHOLIC BASED BEVERAGE EMITTING FROM ██████████ BREATH AND OBSERVED ██████████ EYES TO BE SEVERELY BLOODSHOT. ██████████ WAS VERY SLOW TO RESPOND TO R/O'S QUESTIONS, HIS SPEECH PATTERN WAS DISORGANIZED, AND AT TIMES UNINTELLIGIBLE. ██████████ ALSO SEVERELY SLURRED HIS SPEECH WHEN SPEAKING. R/O ASKED ██████████ WHERE HE WAS GOING TO / RETURNING FROM. ██████████ RESPONDED IN A SLEEPY / DAZED STATE "I'M GOING TO MY JOB...THREE O'CLOCK NINE O'CLOCK...MAN". R/O ASKED ██████████ IF HE HAD BEEN DRINKING ALCOHOLIC BASED BEVERAGES EARLIER IN THE EVENING / MORNING. ██████████ REPLIED THAT HE HADN'T. R/O THEN ASKED ██████████ IF HE KNEW WHAT TIME IT WAS WITHOUT LOOKING AT A TIME

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PIECE. [REDACTED] REQUESTED THAT R/O TO REPEAT THE QUESTION. AFTER R/O REPEATED THE QUESTION [REDACTED] DID NOT GIVE AN AUDIBLE REPLY.

R/O ASKED [REDACTED] TO EXIT THE CHRYSLER NEW YORKER TO PERFORM STANDARD FIELD SOBRIETY TESTS. UPON EXITING THE VEHICLE [REDACTED] EXHIBITED EXTREME DIFFICULTY MAINTAINING HIS BALANCE IN THAT HE STAGGERED WHEN WALKING AND SWAYED WHILE STANDING IN ONE PLACE.

[REDACTED] CONTINUED TO HAVE DIFFICULTY MAINTAINING HIS BALANCE THROUGH THE REMAINDER OF THE TESTING PROCESS. [REDACTED] WAS ESCORTED TO A SAFE AND LEVEL AREA OF PAVEMENT AND ASKED TO PERFORM THE FOLLOWING FIELD SOBRIETY TESTS.

- THE ONE LEGGED STAND TEST:

R/O GAVE VERBAL INSTRUCTION AND DEMONSTRATED THE PROPER WAY TO EXECUTE THE ONE LEGGED STAND TEST WITH OBSERVATION THAT [REDACTED] HAD LIMITED KNOWLEDGE OF THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE. AFTER VERIFYING THAT [REDACTED] UNDERSTOOD R/O'S INSTRUCTION, HE WAS ASKED TO PERFORM THE TEST. ON THE FIRST ATTEMPT [REDACTED] WAS ONLY ABLE TO HOLD HIS RIGHT FOOT UP OFF THE GROUND FOR THREE SECONDS BEFORE PLACING IT DOWN TO MAINTAIN HIS BALANCE. ON THE SECOND ATTEMPT [REDACTED] WAS ONLY ABLE TO RAISE HIS RIGHT FOOT FOR TWO SECONDS BEFORE PLACING IT ON THE GROUND TO MAINTAIN HIS BALANCE.

- THE WALK AND TURN TEST ON A LEVEL SURFACE:

R/O GAVE VERBAL INSTRUCTION AND DEMONSTRATED THE PROPER WAY TO EXECUTE THE ONE LEGGED STAND TEST WITH OBSERVATION THAT [REDACTED] HAD LIMITED KNOWLEDGE OF THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE. AFTER VERIFYING THAT [REDACTED] UNDERSTOOD R/O'S INSTRUCTION, HE WAS ASKED TO PERFORM THE TEST. ON THE FIRST ATTEMPT [REDACTED] TOOK ONE STEP HESITATED FOR SEVERAL SECONDS BEFORE TAKING ANOTHER STEP BEFORE STOPPING. [REDACTED] DID NOT TOUCH HEEL TO TOW OR TAKE THE NINE STEPS PER INSTRUCTION. [REDACTED] PERFORMED SO POORLY ON THIS TEST THAT R/O REQUESTED SGT. GOMEZ #504 TRANSLATE IN THE SPANISH LANGUAGE AS R/O RE-INSTRUCTED [REDACTED] AS TO THE CORRECT WAY TO PERFORM THE TEST. ON THE SECOND ATTEMPT [REDACTED] AGAIN TOOK ONE STEP AND HESITATED. [REDACTED] BEGAN TO LOSE HIS BALANCE TO THE POINT WHERE R/O HAD TO GRAB AND STABILIZE [REDACTED] TO PREVENT HIM FROM FALLING TO THE GROUND. R/O DID NOT REQUEST [REDACTED] TO PERFORM THE TEST FOR THE THIRD TIME.

-THE FINGER TO NOSE TEST:

R/O GAVE VERBAL INSTRUCTION AND DEMONSTRATED THE PROPER WAY TO DEMONSTRATE THE FINGER TO NOSE TEST AND HAD SGT. GOMEZ #504 TRANSLATE R/O'S INSTRUCTION IN THE SPANISH LANGUAGE TO ENSURE [REDACTED] UNDERSTOOD. AFTER [REDACTED] STATED THAT HE UNDERSTOOD R/O'S INSTRUCTION, HE WAS ASKED TO PERFORM THE TEST. R/O FIRST REQUESTED [REDACTED] TO TOUCH THE TIP OF HIS NOSE WITH HIS LEFT INDEX FINGER. [REDACTED] WAS EXTREMELY UNSTEADY ONCE HE CLOSED HIS EYES AND TILTED HIS HEAD BACK. [REDACTED] TOUCHED THE BRIDGE OF HIS NOSE AND WOULD NOT RESPOND TO R/O OR SGT. GOMEZ'S INSTRUCTION TO RELEASE HIS FINGER. R/O FOR THE SECOND TIME HAD TO GRAB [REDACTED] TO PREVENT HIM FROM FALLING TO THE GROUND.

AT THIS TIME R/O REASONABLY BELIEVED THAT [REDACTED] WAS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL AND UNFIT TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE. [REDACTED] WAS PLACED UNDER ARREST AND TRANSPORTED TO B.P.D. FOR PROCESSING.

ONCE AT B.P.D. [REDACTED] EXHIBITED DIFFICULTY EXITING THE REAR OF B.P.D. SQUAD #02 EVEN WITH R/O'S ASSISTANCE. R/O HAD TO STABILIZE [REDACTED] TWICE WHILE WALKING UP THE REAR STAIRS OF THE BENSENVILLE POLICE STATION TO PREVENT HIM FROM FALLING. ONCE UNDER CONTROLLED CONDITIONS THE AFFECTS OF ALCOHOL BASED BEVERAGE CONSUMPTION WAS EVIDENT. PRIOR TO STARTING ANY PAPER WORK [REDACTED] INFORMED R/O THAT HE HAD TO URINATE AND WOULD BE UNABLE TO "HOLD IT" MUCH LONGER. R/O ESCORTED [REDACTED] TO B.P.D. CELL #4 WHERE HE COULD USE A TOILET . R/O STOOD

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APPROXIMATELY SIX BEHIND [REDACTED] AS HE URINATED. [REDACTED] PLACED HIS HAND ON THE WALL TO MAINTAIN HIS BALANCE AND WAS OBSERVED MISSING THE TOILET SEVERAL TIMES, URINATING ON BOTH THE FLOOR AND WALL. [REDACTED] CONTINUED TO EXHIBIT EXTREME DIFFICULTY MAINTAINING HIS BALANCE AND BEGAN TO EXHIBIT MOOD SWINGS FROM BEING COOPERATIVE TO UNCOOPERATIVE AND EMOTIONALLY UPSET TO INDIFFERENT.

AT 0540 HOURS, R/O READ [REDACTED] HIS WARNING TO MOTORIST AND [REDACTED] AGREED TO SUBMIT TO A BLOOD ALCOHOL CONCENTRATION BREATH (B.A.C.) TEST. B.P.D. DID NOT HAVE AN OFFICER ON DUTY CERTIFIED TO ADMINISTER A B.A.C. BREATH TEST SO R/O TRANSPORTED ECHEVARRIA TO THE CITY OF WOOD DALE POLICE STATION TO MEET WITH WOOD DALE POLICE OFFICER WEIDNER #137 WHO WAS CERTIFIED IN ISSUING THE TEST. [REDACTED] WAS OBSERVED FOR THE REQUIRED AMOUNT OF TIME AND DID NOT BELCH, REGURGITATE, VOMIT, OR PUT ANYTHING IN HIS MOUTH DURING THAT TIME. AT 0628 HOURS, WOOD DALE POLICE OFFICER WEIDNER REQUESTED [REDACTED] PERFORM THE BREATH TEST. [REDACTED] BECAME UNCOOPERATIVE AND REFUSED.

AT THIS TIME REQUESTED [REDACTED] TURN AROUND AND PLACE HIS HANDS BEHIND HIS BACK SO HE COULD BE HANDCUFFED FOR THE TRANSPORT BACK TO B.P.D. [REDACTED] IGNORED R/O'S FIRST AND FOLLOWING SECOND REQUEST. R/O THEN GRABBED A HOLD OF [REDACTED] LEFT ELBOW IN AN ATTEMPT TO TURN [REDACTED] BODY IN A POSITION WHERE HE COULD BE HANDCUFFED. WHILE ATTEMPTING TO HANDCUFF [REDACTED] [REDACTED] LOST HIS BALANCE AND FELL FORWARD STRIKING HIS HEAD AGAINST A SMALL LEDGE LOCATED IN THE WOOD DALE POLICE DEPARTMENT BOOKING ROOM. [REDACTED] SUSTAINED A SMALL CUT ABOVE HIS LEFT EYE WHEN STRIKING THE LEDGE.

ONCE AT B.P.D. [REDACTED] REQUESTED MEDICAL ATTENTION FOR THE SMALL CUT ABOVE HIS LEFT EYE. B.F.D. E.M.S. MEDIC #78 RESPONDED AND AT [REDACTED] REQUEST WAS TRANSPORTED TO ELMHURST MEMORIAL HOSPITAL BY MEDIC #78 TO BE TREATED. R/O FOLLOWED MEDIC #78 AND STAYED WITH [REDACTED] WHILE AT THE HOSPITAL. [REDACTED] WAS TREATED BY ELMHURST MEMORIAL MEDICAL STAFF AND PRIOR TO RELEASE AGREED TO SUBMIT TO A BLOOD DRAW TO DETERMINE HIS B.A.C. AT APPROXIMATELY 0750 HOURS A D.U.I. KIT WAS COMPLETED AND LATER ENTERED INTO EVIDENCE. AT APPROXIMATELY 0835 HOURS, R/O TRANSPORTED [REDACTED] BACK TO B.P.D. WHERE HE WAS FINGERPRINTED / PHOTOGRAPHED.

[REDACTED] WAS READ HIS RIGHTS PURSUANT TO THE MIRANDA DECISION PER PREPRINTED FORM AND SIGNED THE FORM THE RIGHTS WERE READ FROM. [REDACTED] STATED THAT HE UNDERSTOOD HIS RIGHTS AND DECLINED TO ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS ON THE REVERSE SIDE OF B.P.D. ALCOHOL INFLUENCE REPORT FORM #02-9775.
