LEARN TO SKATE—Tot, Beginner, Pre-Alpha (Basic 1/2)

Learn to skate classes give every skater the opportunity to learn the basics of ice skating whether figure skating or hockey is your goal. Upon completion of learn to skate you have the option of participating in pre-hockey or the Crystal Edges Figure Skating Program



CRYSTAL EDGE SKATING ADVANCED SKATING PROGRAM

The Crystal Edges program is designed for skaters with the interest in taking their skating to a more concentrated level. Skaters follow the curriculum of the Ice Sports Industry and US Figure Skating. Skaters have the opportunity to participate in on and off ice specialty classes, ice shows, competitions, and team skating.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Class Min. 4 Max 12 Skating director reserves the right to combine classes if necessary

Register for a second class and receive that class for 1/2 off. Class must be same session and same skater

SKATES: Rental is \$2 per week for skate school. 10 week skate rental pass available for your convenience. Public skate rental \$3. It is highly recommended that all skaters learn in regular skates before attempting to master hockey skates.

HOCKEY SKATES will not be permitted for Tot classes for at least first half of session, may try with instructor's approval only

Please consult with the skating director or instructors prior to making an ice skate purchase. Our experience can guide you to the right skate for your child.

ATTIRE: Dress for warmth but no need to bulk. No snowsuits, snow pants, plastic knee pads. Helmets are optional and encouraged but not required. Bike helmets are fine. **Gloves a MUST!**

Most classes are 40 minutes. Tot and Beginner classes are 30 minutes of instruction with 10 minutes of practice time

MAKE-UPS: Make up classes will be permitted ONLY if class space allows. A skater must obtain a "make-up" slip prior to showing up for class. Classes cannot be make up on the first or last day of the session and must be made up within the same session. Limit of 1 make up per session. As the Winter sessions tend to be full, **NO MAKE UPS WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE WINTER SESSIONS.**

REFUND POLICY: Refund requests and or credits will be granted only until the end of second week of classes, less classes skated. Registration fee not refundable.

EVALUATIONS AND TESTING: Skaters in full 10 week sessions will be evaluated in weeks 5 and 9. If a skater is given a referral to test, he or she will be evaluated by the director on last week of session. If a skater advances to the next level there is a \$3 test registration fee, which includes a patch and certificate of completion.
