These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when complied without possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

ON 08-30-04 AT APPROXIMATELY 0100 HOURS R/O RETURNED TO [REDACTED] TO TAKE EVIDENTIARY PHOTO'S. THESE PHOTOS WERE TAKEN WITH THE DEPARTMENT OWNED DIGITAL CAMERA, A SONY MVC-FD73.

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WHEN R/O ENTERED THE APARTMENT, THE WHITE METAL/MESH GARBAGE CAN THAT HAD BEEN KICKED BY THE OFFENDER HAD BEEN PLACED BACK IN THE BEDROOM. DUE TO LIGHTING CONDITIONS R/O PICKED UP THE GARBAGE CAN AND PLACED IT IN A CHAIR IN THE LIVING ROOM UNDER A LIGHT. WHEN R/O PICKED UP THE GARBAGE CAN IT APPEARED TO BE IN THE SAME DENTED CONDITION AS WHEN R/O'S LEFT THE APARTMENT EARLIER.

R/O TOOK FOUR DIGITAL PHOTOS (ONE THROUGH FOUR) OF THE WHITE METAL/MESH GARBAGE CAN AT DIFFERENT ANGLES TO SHOW THE DAMAGE AND FORCE NEED TO CAUSE SUCH DAMAGE.

DIGITAL PHOTO'S FIVE AND SIX ARE OF THE INSIDE OF THE APARTMENT. PHOTO FIVE IS FROM THE LIVING ROOM LOOKING TOWARDS THE KITCHEN. IN THE PHOTO THE BEDROOM DOOR IS IN THE HALLWAY ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE JUST BEFORE THE KITCHEN. THIS IS WHERE THE GARBAGE CAN WAS WHEN THE OFFENDER KICKED IT. PHOTO SIX IS THE REVERSE OF FIVE AND IS FROM THE KITCHEN LOOKING TOWARDS THE LIVING ROOM. IN THIS PHOTO THE BEDROOM DOOR IS IN THE HALLWAY ON THE LEFT BEFORE THE LIVING ROOM. THE LIVING ROOM IS WHERE THE GARBAGE CAN FLEW TO AND STRUCK THE JUVENILE AFTER BEING KICKED.

DIGITAL PHOTO'S SEVEN THROUGH ELEVEN ARE OF THE CHILD AND HIS INJURIES. THE CHILD WAS BEING HELD BY HIS MOTHER AND WAS RESTLESS. THE CHILD HAS A SMALL RED MARK ABOVE HIS RIGHT EYE WHERE HE WAS STRUCK BY THE GARBAGE CAN.

ON 08-29-04 AT APPROXIMATELY 2305 HOURS, R/O WAS DISPATCHED TO THE [REDACTED] APARTMENT BUILDING FOR THE REPORT OF AN ADULT FATHER WHO HAD STRUCK HIS INFANT SON. COMPLAINANT WAS WITH A FRIEND IN APARTMENT [REDACTED] AND REPORTED OFFENDER IN APARTMENT [REDACTED] WHERE THE INCIDENT OCCURED.

R/O FIRST WENT TO APARTMENT [REDACTED] AND SPOKE WITH COMPLAINANT, [REDACTED], WHO RELATED THE FOLLOWING IN SUMMARY THROUGH THE SPANISH TO ENGLISH TRANSLATION OF ASSISTING OFFICER SANBORN #28. [REDACTED] HAS BEEN MARRIED TO HUSBAND / OFFENDER, CARLOS JAVIER PAULINO (M/W [REDACTED]), FOR APPROXIMATELY TWO YEARS. DURING WHICH TIME [REDACTED] AND PAULINO HAD ONE INFANT SON TOGETHER (APPROXIMATELY ONE YEAR OLD, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS JUVENILE #1, SEE JUVENILE CONTACT FORM #04-10898 FOR FURTHER). PAULINO, [REDACTED] AND JUVENILE #1 CURRENTLY RESIDE IN APARTMENT [REDACTED] THE APARTMENT IS LAYED OUT WITH TWO ENTRANCES, ONE NORTH FACING ENTRANCE IN THE KITCHEN AND ONE WEST FACING ENTRANCE IN THE LIVING ROOM. THE KITCHEN AND LIVING ROOM ARE SEPARATED BY A SMALL HALLWAY CONTAINING A WEST ENTRANCE TO A BATHROOM AND EAST ENTRANCE TO THE SINGLE BEDROOM.

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ON 08-29-04 AT APPROXIMATELY 2245 HOURS, PAULINO WAS SEATED AT A DESK BEHIND A COMPUTER LOCATED IN THE LIVING ROOM OF THEIR RENTED APARTMENT. PAULINO AND [REDACTED] WHERE ARGUING OVER OPERATIONAL PROBLEMS THEY HAVE BEEN HAVING WITH THE COMPUTER. JUVENILE #1 WAS WALKING AROUND THE ROOM ASSISTED BY A BABY WALKER. AT WHICH TIME JUVENILE #1 WALKED / ROLLED OVER TO THE DESK CONTAINING THE COMPUTER. JUVENILE #1 PROCEEDED TO REACH UP, GRAB HOLD OF A HANGING WIRE ATTACHED TO A COMPUTER MOUSE, AND PULL DOWN ON THE WIRE. PAULINO BECAME UPSET, PULLED THE WIRE OUT OF THE JUVENILE'S HAND, YELLED AT THE JUVENILE, AND SLAPPED THE JUVENILE'S HAND.

[REDACTED] DID NOT APPROVE OF THE DISCIPLINE AND THE ARGUMENT ESCALATED AND BROADENED. PAULINO FELT THE VOLUME ON AN UNATTENDED TELEVISION PLAYING IN THE SINGLE BEDROOM OF THE RESIDENCE WAS TOO LOUD. PAULINO THEN WENT SEARCHING AROUND THE RESIDENCE FOR A HAMMER TO SMASH THE SCREEN. WHEN PAULINO COULD NOT FIND A HAMMER, PAULINO RUSHED INTO THE BEDROOM AND SHUT THE TELEVISION OFF. UPON EXITING THE BEDROOM PAULINO KICKED A METAL WIRE MESH TRASH BASKET (POSITIONED AT THE DOOR WAY OF THE BEDROOM) INTO THE HALLWAY.

JUVENILE #1 WAS STILL LOCATED IN THE LIVING ROOM WALKING AROUND THE ROOM IN THE BABY WALKER. THE METAL MESH TRASH BASKET BOUNCED / RICOCHETED OFF THE HALLWAY WALL / FLOOR INTO THE LIVING ROOM STRIKING JUVENILE #1 IN THE FACE. [REDACTED] FEARED FOR HER AND JUVENILE #1'S SAFETY AND LEFT THE APARTMENT TO A FRIENDS LOCATED IN APARTMENT [REDACTED]. FROM THERE [REDACTED] TELEPHONED B.P.D.

R/O OBSERVED MINOR SKIN REDNESS AND IRRITATION ABOVE THE RIGHT EYE OF THE JUVENILE WHERE HE WAS REPORTEDLY STRUCK BY THE TRASH BASKET. [REDACTED] STATED PAULINO HAS ANGER PROBLEMS AND HAS STRUCK [REDACTED] ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS IN THE PAST.

R/O WENT TO APARTMENT [REDACTED] TO SPEAK WITH PAULINO. UPON APPROACHING THE NORTH ENTRANCE R/O OBSERVED PAULINO TINKERING WITH THE DEAD BOLT LOCK. THE DOOR KNOB HANDLE DOES NOT LOCK AND THE DEAD BOLT IS ONLY MEANS OF SECURING THE DOOR. R/O ASKED PAULINO TO IDENTIFY HIMSELF AND INQUIRED WHAT HE WAS DOING WITH THE LOCK. PAULINO IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AND STATED HE WAS FIXING THE DEAD BOLT.

R/O BEGAN TO QUESTION PAULINO ON EVENTS THAT HAD OCCURED PRIOR TO BEING DISPATCHED TO THE APARTMENT. PAULINO WAS AT FIRST UNCOOPERATIVE AND ELUSIVE WITH ANSWERS. PAULINO DENIED ANYTHING HAPPENED OTHER THAN A VERBAL ARGUMENT. UPON FURTHER QUESTIONING PAULINO ADMITTED TO KICKING THE STATED TRASH BASKET INTO THE HALLWAY OF THE RESIDENCE OUT OF FRUSTRATION WITH THE ARGUMENT HE HAD WITH [REDACTED]. PAULINO STATED THE TRASH BASKET DID NOT STRIKE THE JUVENILE NOR WAS PAULINO ATTEMPTING TO STRIKE THE JUVENILE WITH THE TRASH BASKET. PAULINO DID HAVE KNOWLEDGE THAT THE JUVENILE WAS IN THE LIVING ROOM AT THE TIME THE TRASH BASKET WAS KICKED. R/O OBSERVED THE TRASH BASKET WHICH WAS BENT AND OUT OF SHAPE.

A CHECK THROUGH L.E.A.D.S. VIA B.P.D. DISPATCH REVEALED PAULINO HAD AN ACTIVE FAILURE TO APPEAR DOMESTIC BATTERY WARRANT OUT OF DUPAGE COUNTY:

- WARRANT [REDACTED]
- ISSUED 11-17-2003 BY AN UNKNOWN DUPAGE COUNTY JUDGE
- BOND SET AT \$10,000.00 / 10%
- L.E.A.D.S. #W04A4773
- WARRANT CONFIRMED WITH DUPAGE COUNTY SHERIFF'S POLICE DEPARTMENT ON 08-29-04 / 2338 HOURS.

PAULINO WAS PLACED UNDER ARREST FOR THE F.T.A. WARRANT AND CHARGE OF ENDANGERING THE LIFE OF CHILD. WHILE CONDUCTING A SEARCH OF PAULINO, R/O NOTICED A SET OF KEYS PAULINO HAD IN HIS FRONT POCKET. PAULINO WAS PLACED IN R/O'S SQUAD CAR AND [REDACTED] ADVISED OF THE ARREST. UPON

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RETURNING TO THE APARTMENT, [REDACTED] INQUIRED WHAT HAD HAPPENED TO THE DEAD BOLT ON THE DOOR. [REDACTED] EXPLAINED THAT THE LOCK WAS FULLY OPERATIONAL JUST PRIOR TO LEAVING THE APARTMENT TO TELEPHONE B.P.D. R/O EXPLAINED PAULINO RELATED THE LOCK WAS BROKEN AND WAS ATTEMPTING TO FIX THE LOCK WHEN R/O MADE CONTACT.

[REDACTED] INSISTED THE LOCK WAS NEVER BROKEN AND EXPRESSED CONCERN THAT THE DEAD BOLT LOCK WAS THE ONLY MEANS OF SECURING THE NORTH ENTRANCE DOOR. OFFICER SANBORN #28 REATTACHED THE DEAD BOLT TO THE DOOR. THE DEAD BOLT FUNCTIONED PROPERLY. [REDACTED] THEN EXPRESSED CONCERN THAT HER KEYS WERE MISSING FROM THE APARTMENT. [REDACTED] DESCRIBED HER SET OF KEYS WITH KEY CHAIN EMBLEM TO R/O. R/O REMEMBERED THE DESCRIBED SET OF KEYS TO BE SIMILAR OR THE SAME AS THE SET OF KEYS IN PAULINO'S POCKET. R/O RECOVERED THE SET OF KEYS FROM PAULINO AND SHOWED THEM TO [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] WAS CERTAIN THAT THE SET OF KEYS SHOWN WERE THE SOLE SET OF RESIDENT KEYS BELONGING TO [REDACTED]. THE KEYS WERE LEFT WITH [REDACTED] AND PAULINO TRANSPORTED TO B.P.D. FOR PROCESSING.

DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHS OF JUVENILE #1'S INJURIES, APARTMENT LAYOUT, AND TRASH BASKET WERE TAKEN BY OFFICER SANBORN #28. THE DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPH DISK WAS PLACED INTO EVIDENCE BY OFFICER SANBORN #28 (REFER TO SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT #04-10989 SUBMITTED BY OFFICER SANBORN #28).

ONCE AT B.P.D., PAULINO WAS PHOTOGRAPHED, FINGERPRINTED, AND ISSUED HIS COPY OF THE SINGLE COMPLAINT IN VIOLATION OF 720 ILCS 5/12-21.6 - ENDANGERING THE LIFE OF A CHILD. PAULINO WAS ISSUED A COURT DATE OF 10-07-04 / 0830 HOURS AT THE DUPAGE COUNTY COURTHOUSE IN WHEATON, IL. PAULINO WAS ABLE TO POST \$1,000.00 / 10% BOND ON THE B.P.D. INITIATED CHARGE (BAIL BOND FORM #BB547694) BUT UNABLE TO POST BOND ON THE F.T.A. WARRANT. PAULINO WAS HELD AWAITING EXTRADITION TO THE DUPAGE COUNTY JAIL.


