Re: March 12, 2016 FOIA Request

Dear Mr. Herrera:

I am pleased to help you with your March 12, 2016 Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"). Your request was received by the Village of Bensenville on March 14, 2016. You requested copies of the items indicated below:

"Dog bite on 1/25/16. Officer Caliendo 511. Case number 16-764."

After a search of Village files, the following documents are enclosed to fulfill your request:

- 1) Village of Bensenville Crime Report No. BV16000764.1. (2 pgs.)

These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when complied without possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

Report Narrative: On 012516 at approximately 2145 hours, R/O responded to the Bensenville Police Department lobby for a delayed animal bite report. Upon arrival, R/O met with [REDACTED] who stated the following in summary:

[REDACTED] and his girlfriend were running in the neighborhood around the area of Memorial and Judson. [REDACTED] stated that he observed a male walking his dog in front of them a little ways down on Memorial. [REDACTED] then observed a vehicle pulling out of a driveway which caused the male and the dog to stop. [REDACTED] and his girlfriend ran up and stopped near the male and the dog. [REDACTED] stated that the dog, described as a brown Bloodhound, jumped up and bit him under the right armpit. [REDACTED] stated that they spoke with the male, identified as Matt Brown, who cooperated and exchanged information. [REDACTED] then went to Elmhurst Hospital to be evaluated.

On 01/26/16 at approximately 1800 hours, R/O contacted Matthew N Brown mw [REDACTED] who stated the following in summary:

Matthew stated that he was walking his dog on leash down Memorial St. Matthew stated that it was dark and he had his hood up due to the rain. Matthew stated that between Barron and Judson, he was stopped due to a car coming out of the driveway. Matthew pulled the dog back away from the driveway so that the dog didn't get hit by the car pulling out. Matthew stated that when he pulled the dog away, the dog circled around behing him. Matthew felt a tug on the leash and when he turned around the dog was up on two legs jumping on a male runner. Matthew asked if he was ok and he stated he was and both parties continued on their way. Matthew stated that he was on Wood when the male and female runners ran back up to him to let him know that the male was bleeding and needed to exchange information. Matthew stated that he was also contacted by DuPage County Animal Control and he had recently took his dog, Jed, a brown Bloodhound, back to the vet to get checked out.

R/O faxed a completed dog bite form to DuPage Animal Control on 01/26/16.
