These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.


Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when complied without possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

Report Narrative: **ON 27 APRIL 2016 AT APPROXIMATELY 1545 HOURS, R/O WAS DISPATCHED TO [REDACTED] FOR A SUICIDE THREAT - CRISIS INTERVENTION. THE COMPLAINANT, WALESKA GILES ([REDACTED]), IDENTIFIED HERSELF AS A CONCERNED SISTER OF THE SUICIDAL SUBJECT, CARLOS ORTIZ ([REDACTED]). GILES EXPLAINED SHE JUST RECEIVED A TELEPHONE CALL FROM ORTIZ. GILES RELATED ORTIZ STATED HE WAS GOING TO COMMIT SUICIDE AND CALLED TO SAY "GOODBYE". THE MEANS IN WHICH ORTIZ PLANNED ON COMMITTING SUICIDE WAS UNCLEAR TO GILES, BUT MENTIONED ORTIZ MAY ATTEMPT TO TAKE HIS LIFE BY INGESTING AN UNSPECIFIED SUBSTANCE AND / OR PILLS. ORTIZ WAS BELIEVED TO BE ALONE (OTHER THAN FIVE DOGS KEPT ON THE PROPERTY) AND REGULARLY STAYED IN THE BASEMENT. GILES EXPRESSED EXTREME CONCERN FOR ORTIZ AS HE REPORTEDLY EITHER EXPRESSED SUICIDAL THOUGHTS AND / OR ATTEMPTED TO TAKE HIS LIFE IN THE PAST.**

R/O HAD PREVIOUS KNOWLEDGE THAT ORTIZ NEITHER LIKED NOR TRUSTED THE POLICE. R/O ASKED DISPATCH TO CONTACT GILES AND REQUEST SHE HAVE A FAMILY MEMBER OR TRUSTED FRIEND RESPOND TO THE RESIDENCE TO ASSIST IN THE CRISIS INTERVENTION. DISPATCH COMPLIED AND ADVISED THAT BOTH GILES AND ORTIZ'S MOTHER WERE OUT OF STATE IN DENVER, COLORADO. GILES WAS UNABLE TO ARRANGE TO HAVE ANYONE ELSE RESPOND TO THE RESIDENCE.

R/O ARRIVED ON SCENE A SHORT TIME LATER. R/O DECIDED TO FIRST GO TO THE NEIGHBORING RESIDENCE TO THE NORTH. R/O MADE CONTACT WITH A RESIDENT INSIDE. R/O DID NOT DEVOLVE THE NATURE OF THE CALL BUT INQUIRED IF HE OR ANYONE INSIDE THE HOME HAD A FRIENDSHIP OR REPORE WITH ORTIZ. THE SAID NEIGHBOR WAS UNABLE TO PROVIDE ANY ASSISTANCE.

AFTER SPEAKING WITH THE SAID NEIGHBOR, R/O TURNED TOWARDS THE [REDACTED] RESIDENCE. AT THIS TIME R/O OBSERVED A MALE SUBJECT EMERGING FROM THE HOME. R/O MADE CONTACT WITH THE SUBJECT WHO IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS A FRIEND / ROOMMATE OF ORTIZ. R/O DISCRETELY EXPLAINED THE NATURE OF THE CALL AND REQUESTED THE SUBJECT'S ASSISTANCE. IN AN EFFORT NOT TO ANTAGONIZE ORTIZ, IT WAS DECIDED THAT THE SUBJECT WOULD SPEAK WITH AND HAVE ORTIZ MEET WITH R/O OUTSIDE THE RESIDENCE. PRIOR TO GOING BACK INSIDE THE RESIDENCE, THE SUBJECT APPEARED NERVOUS AND RELATED THAT ORTIZ WAS NOT GOING TO BE HAPPY.

R/O AND ASSISTING OFFICER VALIOS #62 REMAINED OUTSIDE THE RESIDENCE AND WAITED FOR ORTIZ TO EXIT THE HOME. A FEW MINUTES LATER, ORTIZ EMERGED FROM THE SIDE DOOR (NORTH SIDE OF RESIDENCE). ORTIZ QUICKLY OPENED A CLOSED GATE AND BEGAN TO WALK TOWARDS R/O STATING "WE GOT A PROBLEM". ORTIZ APPEARED AGITATED AND WAS WALKING AT AN EXTREMELY FAST PACE. R/O CALMLY WALKED TOWARDS ORTIZ AND MET WITH HIM ON THE SIDE DRIVEWAY.

THROUGH SEVERAL INTERRUPTIONS R/O FINISHED EXPLAINING THE NATURE OF THE CONTACT. ORTIZ APPEARED TO BE HAVING COGNITIVE ISSUES OR WAS PURPOSELY NOT LISTENING TO R/O. ORTIZ CONTINUALLY INTERRUPTED R/O AND WOULD ASK SEVERAL OF THE SAME QUESTIONS MULTIPLE TIMES OVER. ORTIZ CONTINUALLY DEMANDED TO KNOW WHO CALLED FOR THE CHECK. WHEN PROVIDED WITH THE SAME CONSISTENT ANSWER, ORTIZ WOULD PROCEED TO CONTRADICT HIMSELF BY EITHER DENYING HE SPOKE WITH GILES OR DENYING HE MADE ANY SUICIDAL STATEMENTS WHEN HE DID SPEAK WITH HER.

ORTIZ CHALLENGED R/O'S PRESENCE AND DEMANDED TO KNOW WHY HE WAS BEING HARASSED. R/O EXPLAINED THAT THE POLICE WERE CALLED TO THE RESIDENCE AND WERE FULFILLING A COMMUNITY CARETAKING ROLL THROUGH CRISIS INTERVENTION. R/O ASSURED ORTIZ THAT THE CONTACT WAS NOT IN ANYWAY A CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION. DURING THE ENTIRE INTERACTION, ORTIZ WAS SPEAKING LOUDLY AND / OR YELLING AT R/O. R/O ASKED ORTIZ TO CALM HIS EMOTIONS AND SPEAK WITH R/O ABOUT WHAT WAS SAID ON THE TELEPHONE TO GILES. ORTIZ REMAINED ARGUMENTATIVE BUT AT ONE POINT DID STATE HE WAS "FINE".

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R/O ATTEMPTED TO BUILD ON THE SAID COMMENT THAT HE WAS "FINE". R/O ENCOURAGED ORTIZ TO ELABORATE WHAT HE ACTUALLY MEANT WHEN HE STATED "FINE". ORTIZ REMAINED AGITATED AND UNCOOPERATIVE. AT ONE POINT ORTIZ STATED HE NEEDED TO GET TO WORK AND WAS NOT OBLIGATED TO TELL R/O "SHIT".

DURING THE ENTIRE VERBAL INTERACTION, R/O WAS UNABLE TO MAINTAIN ANY SEMBLANCE OF CONTROL OF THE CONVERSATION OR SCENE. ORTIZ CONTINUALLY BOUNCED BACK AND FORTH TOWARDS R/O WHILE YELLING. ORTIZ ALSO WOULD TAKE A FEW STEPS AWAY THEN QUICKLY CLOSE IN ON R/O AS ALMOST TO PROVOKE A PHYSICAL ALTERCATION. R/O REMAINED ON GUARD BUT WAS TOLERANT OF THE CHALLENGING BEHAVIOR KEEPING IN MIND THE REASON FOR THE INTERACTION.

ORTIZ'S ERRATIC BEHAVIOR MADE IT IMPOSSIBLE FOR R/O TO MAKE A DETERMINATION AS TO HIS STATE OF MIND AND / OR HEALTH. R/O BEGAN TO SUSPECT ORTIZ CONSUMED SOME TYPE OF STIMULANT OR AMPHETAMINE. UNCOMFORTABLE WITH LEAVING THE SITUATION AS IT STOOD AND HAVING EXHAUSTED ALL OPTIONS, R/O LOOKED OVER AND REQUESTED OFFICER VALIOS #62 RADIO FOR BENSENVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT PARAMEDICS.

THE REQUEST FOR MEDICS AGITATED ORTIZ EVEN MORE. ORTIZ MOVED DIRECTLY TOWARDS R/O WHILE STATING HE WAS LEAVING FOR WORK AND DIDN'T HAVE TO TALK TO THE RESPONDING MEDICS. AT THIS POINT, R/O REACHED FORWARD AND PERFORMED A SIMPLE CONTROLLED CALF SWEEP (R/O'S RIGHT CALF TO THE INSIDE OF ORTIZ'S RIGHT CALF) WHICH TOOK ORTIZ SAFELY TO THE GROUND. ONCE ON THE GROUND ORTIZ WAS INSTRUCTED TO PLACE HIS HANDS BEHIND HIS BACK. AT FIRST ORTIZ REFUSED WHILE KEEPING HIS LEFT ARM UNDER HIS BODY. R/O APPLIED A SIMPLE PAIN COMPLIANCE HOLD TO ORTIZ'S RIGHT WRIST WHICH GAINED COMPLIANCE.

ORTIZ WAS SUCCESSFULLY RESTRAINED THROUGH THE USE OF HANDCUFFS AND ASSISTED OFF THE GROUND TO HIS FEET. ORTIZ WAS INSTRUCTED TO WALK DOWN THE DRIVEWAY TOWARDS R/O'S SQUAD CAR. ORTIZ STRUGGLED TO GET AWAY / BREAK R/O'S HOLD BY PULLING AND JERKING HIS BODY AWAY FROM R/O. AT THIS TIME R/O WAS WALKING ALONG SIDE TO THE RIGHT OF ORTIZ WHILE HOLDING HIS RIGHT ELBOW. ORTIZ IGNORED R/O'S ORDER AND CONTINUED TO PULL AWAY. AT ONE POINT ORTIZ STATED HE WAS AN "MMA FIGHTER" WHO WAS ABOUT TO GO "PRO". SHORTLY AFTER ORTIZ SPUN TO HIS RIGHT AND TOWARDS R/O IN A MOVEMENT CONSISTENT WITH DELIVERING A HEADBUTT TO AN OPPONENT. R/O MOVED TO THE SIDE AWAY FROM ORTIZ, THEN QUICKLY TRANSITIONED TO A DEFENSIVE WRIST LOCK ESCORT.

ORTIZ WAS SUCCESSFULLY ESCORTED TO R/O'S SQUAD WHERE HE WAS TO BE SEARCHED FOR WEAPONS OR ANY OTHER MEANS IN WHICH HE COULD HARM HIMSELF OR RESPONDING MEDICS. DURING THE ESCORT R/O DID NOT OBSERVE ANY ISSUES WITH ORTIZ WALKING BUT OBSERVED THE OPPOSITE IN THAT HE WAS VERY STRONG AND STEADY ON HIS FEET WHILE PULLING AWAY FROM R/O.

ORTIZ WAS LEANED AGAINST THE TRUNK AREA OF THE SAID SQUAD. DURING WHICH TIME, ORTIZ CONTINUED TO STRUGGLE. ORTIZ IGNORED REPEATED ORDERS TO STAND STILL FORCING R/O TO REAPPLY THE PAIN COMPLIANCE WRIST LOCK. ORTIZ WAS EVENTUALLY AND SUCCESSFULLY SEARCHED. DURING WHICH TIME R/O LOCATED AN OLDER PRESCRIPTION PILL BOTTLE IN ORTIZ'S UPPER RIGHT JACKET POCKET . R/O LOOKED INSIDE THE BOTTLE AND NOTICED IT WAS FULL OF A VARIETY OF MISMATCHED PILLS. R/O ALERTED RESPONDING MEDICS OF THE PILL BOTTLE AND OF THE STATEMENT GILES MADE TO DISPATCH CONCERNING HER SUSPICION THAT ORTIZ MIGHT ATTEMPT TO END HIS LIFE BY OVERDOSING ON PILLS.

BENSENVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT PARAMEDICS TRANSPORTED ORTIZ TO ALEXIAN BROTHERS MEDICAL CENTER FOR A PSYCHOLOGICAL EVALUATION AND TO BE EXAMINED FOR PAIN ORTIZ COMPLAINED OF IN HIS ANKLE. SERGEANT FUJA #05 RESPONDED TO THE SCENE AND WAS BRIEFED ON THE INCIDENT. A DEPARTMENT USE OF FORCE REPORT WAS COMPLETED. THIS REPORT IS FOR DOCUMENTATION ONLY. THERE ARE NO CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS PENDING. NOTHING FURTHER.
