
Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

Report Narrative **ON 052116 AT APPROXIMATELY 1512 HOURS, R/O RESPONDED TO 501 INDUSTRIAL DRIVE, TRANSPID INC, FOR A DELAYED DELIVERY CONTAINER THEFT. UPON ARRIVAL, R/O MET WITH TOMASZ LAPIAK MW [REDACTED] WHO STATED THE FOLLOWING IN SUMMARY:**

TOMASZ STATED LAST NIGHT, 052116 AT APPROXIMATELY 0255 HOURS, A TRAILER WAS STOLEN FROM THEIR SHARED TRAILER YARD. TOMASZ STATED THAT HIS COMPANY, TRANSPID, PARKS THEIR TRAILERS AT A YARD AT THE DEAD END OF INDUSTRIAL, JUST NORTH OF THE BUSINESS. THE YARD IS SHARED WITH TURBO EXPRESS, HYPER FOX INC, AND EVERMORE LIFTING GEAR. A DRIVER OF TOMASZ WAS IN THE YARD AT APPROXIMATELY 0255 WHEN HE STATED TO TOMASZ THAT A TRUCK WITHOUT A TRAILER AND A BLACK SUV WITH A FEMALE DRIVER ENTERED THE YARD. THE DRIVER THOUGHT NOTHING OF IT, BECAUSE ITS COMMON FOR A DRIVER TO HAVE THEIR WIVES PICK THEM UP AFTER A SHIFT. THE SUV AND TRUCK LEFT THE YARD AND SOON AFTER, THE DRIVER LEFT AND CLOSED THE GATE. THE DRIVER SECURED THE GATE WITH A COMBINATION PADLOCK THAT IS SHARED BY ALL 4 COMPANIES.

TOMASZ THEN SHOWED R/O A VIDEO THAT SHOWED THE BLACK SUV RETURNING TO THE CLOSED GATE. YOU CAN SEE THE FEMALE SUBJECT EXIT THE VEHICLE AND OPEN THE GATE. THE FEMALE RE-ENTERS THE VEHICLE AND DRIVES AWAY FROM THE LOT. A SHORT TIME LATER, A TRACTOR, DESCRIBED BY TOMASZ AS A 2008/2009 WHITE VOLVO 630 "BOBTAIL". THE TRACTOR HAD NO LETTERS OR MARKINGS. THE TRACTOR ENTERS THE LOT AT 0256 HOURS. AT APPROXIMATELY 0300 HOURS, THE TRACTOR LEAVES WITH THE TRAILER HOOKED ON TO THE BACK.

R/O NOTES THAT THE VIDEO IS VERY GRAINY AND HARD TO SEE SPECIFIC MARKINGS/PLATES.

TOMASZ DESCRIBES THE TRAILER AS A 2013 UTILITY D400, IL TRAILER PLATE OF [REDACTED]. THE TRAILER HAS THE NUMBER "[REDACTED]" ON THE DRIVERS SIDE BEHIND THE CAB AND VERTICALLY ON THE BACK RIGHT DOOR. THE TRAILER IS WORTH APPROXIMATELY \$20,000.00. TOMASZ STATED THAT THE TRAILER WAS ALSO FULL WITH THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

**-KURIG COFFEE MAKERS, UNKNOWN AMOUNT
-JUICES
-CRATE WITH CONSTRUCTION ITEMS**

TOMASZ STATED THAT HE WOULD PROVIDE R/O WITH A COMPLETE LIST AND AMOUNT OF ITEMS IN THE TRAILER AS WELL AS A COPY OF THE VIDEO SURVEILLANCE AT A LATER DATE.

TOMASZ IS WILLING TO SIGN COMPLAINTS IF AN OFFENDER IS LOCATED.

THE TRAILER WAS ENTERED INTO LEADS ON 052116 WITH LEADS NUMBER V16D4738.

Report Narrative	<p>On Monday, at 1033 hours, 05-23-16, ACDC contacted this detective to advise the recovery of the trailer reported stolen in this incident.</p> <p>Elk Grove Police Department recovered the trailer abandoned at 1111 Chase Avenue, Elk Grove Village, IL. Officer O'Neil of the Elk Grove Police Department awaiting the arrival of this detective.</p> <p>While enroute to the scene, R/I noted the weather conditions. The temperature was in the 70's with no precipitation in the last 48 hours.</p> <p>1111 Chase Avenue is located in an industrial park southwest of Route 83 and Touhy Avenue. R/I checked local businesses for cameras pointing towards entry / egress of the area with negative results.</p> <p>Upon arrival at the scene, R/I located the Elk Grove Officer on the east side of All Tile located at 1111 Chase Aveune. Trailer was backed into a parking lot. R/I spoke with the officer, who advised an unknown employee of All Tile had found the trailer blocking their east side docks and moved it out of the way thinking the trailer was one of theirs. This same employee discovered the was not their trailer when he checked the interior and found product not associated with their business. At which time an unknown company representative contacted the police to report the trailer as suspicious. Elk Grove Police arrived on scene and also checked the interior of the trailer to find out who owned the trailer.</p> <p>R/I found the trailer unsecure and with gloves checked the interior to find a partial load of drink mixes and construction equipment.</p> <p>R/I contacted the complainant / victim, Tomasz Lapiak and requested he respond to the area to retrieve his trailer.</p> <p>R/I eventually met with Lapiak on scene who confirmed the load of Kurig Coffee Makers and K Cups were missing. The rest of the load appeared intact. Lapiak visually checked the exterior of the trailer and found no damage. He did point out there was yellow paint on the side walls of the passenger side tires as if the trailer parked next a curb painted yellow.</p> <p>R/I checked the exterior of the trailer and observed partial hand prints in the road grime on the rear doors and driver's side near the landing gear. R/I dusted these areas and only developed partial palm and knife's edge of unknown person's hand. R/I lacked a macro lens to photograph same. R/I also tried lifting the partial palm prints with negative results due to the road grime on the surface of the trailer.</p> <p>R/I verified with ACDC, the trailer was removed from LEADS / NCIC as stolen before releasing same to Mr. Lapiak.</p> <p>Before departing the scene, Mr> Lapiak advised Mr. Rizzo, his landlord had video of the trailer leaving his storage lot around. R/I requested Mr. Lapiak contact Mr. Rizzo and request a copy of the video and submit same to this agency.</p> <p>R/I has no further.</p>

Report Narrative **The following information should be noted:**

On 05/21/16, Tomasz reported that the trailer was attached to a tractor at the time of the theft. Tomasz suspects that when the unknown subject in the SUV pulls into the lot, that a third person was left in the yard to unhook the trailer and move the tractor. Tomasz stated that the type of tractor that stole the trailer was identical, if not the same model as the tractor that was hooked to the Transrapid trailer. Tomasz explained that tractor keys can be universal, and that may explain how entry was possibly gained into his tractor to move it away from the trailer. Tomasz stated that the amount of time that it took for them to take the trailer did not make sense, as it would have taken a longer amount of time to remove the trailer from his tractor and move his tractor out of the way so that the suspect tractor could hook up to the trailer.
