These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.


Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

Report Narrative **ON 7/29/16, AT APPROXIMATELY 2106 HOURS, R/O AND OFC LAPORTE #559, WERE DISPATCHED TO THE LOBBY OF THE BENSENVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR A STOLEN MOTOR VEHICLE. R/O ARRIVED AT THE PD AND MET WITH [REDACTED], F/W, [REDACTED], WHO STATED THAT HER RED IN COLOR DODGE RAM SPRINTER VAN, IL REG. [REDACTED] WAS STOLEN FROM [REDACTED].**

[REDACTED] STATED THAT HER VAN HAS BEEN SITTING IN THE PARKING LOT OF [REDACTED] FOR ABOUT 6 OR 7 MONTHS. [REDACTED] SAID THAT THE DODGE SPRINTER VAN WAS LAST SEEN ON MONDAY, 7/25/16, BETWEEN 5 AND 6 PM BY HER HUSBAND. [REDACTED] TOLD R/O THAT SHE IS SEVERAL MONTHS BEHIND ON HER CAR PAYMENTS. [REDACTED] STATED THAT SHE SPOKE WITH THE OWNER OF FAMILY CHOICE, 1332 W IRVING PARK RD, WHO TOLD HER THAT SHE SAW 2 TOW TRUCKS IN THE PARKING LOT WHERE HER VEHICLE WAS PARKED.

OFC LAPORTE SPOKE WITH PETER, [REDACTED], WHO STATED THAT HE WORKS FOR THE COMPANY THAT OWNS THE PROPERTY OF [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED]. PETER TOLD OFC LAPORTE THAT THE VEHICLE HAD BEEN TOWED, BUT DID NOT KNOW BY WHO OR WHERE IT WAS TOWED TO.

R/O WENT TO [REDACTED] TO VERIFY WHAT TOWING COMPANY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THAT PARTICULAR PARKING LOT. S&S TOWING HAD A SIGN POSTED AT THE PARKING LOT AND R/O HAD DISPATCH CALL S&S TO SEE IF THEY HAD ANY RECORDS OF ANY VEHICLES BEING TOWED FROM THAT LOCATION. S&S REPORTED TO DISPATCH THEY DID NOT HAVE ANY RECORDS OF A VEHICLE BEING TOWED FROM [REDACTED]. DISPATCH ALSO CHECKED WITH OTHER TOWING COMPANIES IN THE AREA AND REPOSSESSORS, WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS.
