Dear Mr. Lyth:

I am pleased to help you with your August 8, 2016 Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"). Your request was received by the Village of Bensenville on August 8, 2016. You requested copies of the items indicated below:

"Arrest record for Bensenville."

After a search of Village files, the following documents are enclosed to fulfill your request:

- 1) All Police Report Re: Zachary Lyth. (25 pgs.)

These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when complied without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

ON 10/21/99 AT ABOUT 19:00 HOURS, DISPATCH ASSIGNED R/O TO A MISSING JUVENILE REPORT ██████████ UPON ARRIVAL R/O MET MARTINEZ-HEIDORN, JOYCE (NMI). MARTINEZ REPORTED HE 15 YEAR OLD SON (SEE MISSING JUVENILE REPORT) DID NOT RETURN HOME FROM YORK HIGH SCHOOL TODAY. HE USUALLY GETS HOME ABOUT 15:30 HOURS. THE LAST TIME SHE SPOKE TO HER SON WAS AT APPROXIMATELY 07:00 HOURS THIS MORNING AS HE LEFT FOR SCHOOL. SHE DID NOT CALL THE SCHOOL TO SEE IF HE EVER SHOWED UP FOR CLASS. MARTINEZ ADVISES R/O HER SON TAKING NUMEROUS MEDICATIONS. HE TAKES "ZOLOFT" FOR DEPRESSION, "ENDEROL" FOR A HEART CONDITION KNOWN AS "LONG QT SYNDROME" AND "CLONIDINE"

FOR ATTENTION DEFICIT SYNDROME. HE TOOK ALL THREE PILLS THIS MORNING BEFORE HE LEFT THE HOUSE, BUT HE NEEDS TO TAKE THEM EVERYDAY.

MARTINEZ STATES HER SON HAS BECOME REALLY ANGRY AND COMBATIVE THE LAST TWO WEEKS AND REFUSES TO LISTEN TO HER OR HIS STEP FATHER. EARLIER THIS EVENING, SHE DECIDED TO REMOVE THE T.V. STEREO AND ALL OTHER PERSONAL ITEMS FROM HER SON'S ROOM EXCEPT THE BED, A DRESSER, A PEN AND PAPER AND SOME CLOTHES. WHILE CLEANING OUT HER SON'S DRESSER DRAWERS, MARTINEZ FOUND SEVERAL FOLDERS CONTAINING LITERATURE ON DIFFERENT ITEMS THAT APPEAR TO HAVE BEEN PULLED OFF THE INTERNET. R/O OBSERVED THE PAPERS AND THE AREAS INCLUDE HOW TO MAKE PLASTIC EXPLOSIVES FROM BLEACH, HOW TO CAUSE TROUBLE IN SCHOOL, RIPPING OFF CHANGE MACHINES, GETTING MONEY OUT PAY PHONES, HOW TO BUILD A BLOW GUN, A GUIDE TO LOCKPICKING, HOW THE LAW PROTECTS JUVENILE OFFENDERS AND COMPUTER HACKING. MARTINEZ ALSO SHOWED R/O A 10" X 7" NOTEBOOK WITH HER SON'S WRITING INSIDE. HE APPEARS TO BE ASKING HIMSELF QUESTIONS, THEN WRITING THE ANSWERS DOWN. HE SPEAKS OF HOW HE HATES HIS PARENTS, HIS SCHOOL. HOW HE IS LAZY AND HE DOES NOT CARE. HE STATES HIS PARENTS ARE NO LONGER RATIONAL. HE SEEMS TO ANSWER A QUESTION ABOUT SUICIDE BY WRITING "YES KILLING MYSELF WHEN I WAS 11." HE ALSO WRITES A DEFINITION OF WHAT HE BELIEVES ANARCHY MEANS AND THAT ANARCHY AND TERRORISM ARE TWO DIFFERENT THINGS. HE STARTS TO WRITE ABOUT BOMBING A BUILDING, BUT THEN THE WRITING STOPS. THERE IS ALSO A DRAWING THAT APPEARS TO BE SOME TYPE OF BUILDING OR ROOM, WITH SEVERAL SMALL SQUARES INDICATING EITHER WINDOWS OR SEATS. R/O PLACED ALL THE FOLDERS AND THE NOTEBOOK INTO EVIDENCE.

MARTINEZ TOLD R/O THAT HER SON ATTEMPTED SUICIDE TWICE WHEN HE WAS 12 YEARS OLD WHILE THEY LIVED IN ELGIN IL. THE FIRST TIME HE THREATENED TO JUMP OFF THE SECOND STORY OF THE HOUSE THEY LIVED IN. THEY WERE ABLE TO GRAB HIM FIRST. THE SECOND TIME, HE TOOK AN OVERDOSE OF HIS HEART MEDICATION "ENDEROL". HE ALSO ATTEMPTED SUICIDE BY REFUSING TO EAT. THIS OCCURED THIS PAST JULY. MARTINEZ ADVISES R/O IF THAT IN THE EVENT HER SON GETS EXTREMELY DEPRESSED OR EXTREMELY ANGRY OR UPSET, HIS HEART COULD STOP FROM HIS CONDITION. SHE TOLD R/O THAT OFFICER VISCONTE FROM ELMHURST P.D. HAD TRIED TO HELP HER SON IN THE PAST AND HE WOULD KNOW MORE THAN ANYONE WITH WHOM AND WHERE HE HANGS OUT IN ELMHURST. HE DOES NOT HANG OUT IN BENSENVILLE. 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WITH ASA DAVE IMIELSKI IN REGARDS TO THIS INCIDENT. IMIELSKI AND R/I AGREED THAT UNLAWFUL USE OF WEAPONS WOULD BE THE CORRECT CHARGE IN THIS MATTER PENDING A WEIGHT OF THE COMPOUND.

ON 11-28-01, R/I RECEIVED THE COMPOUND BACK FROM THE LAB. THE TOTAL WEIGHT OF THE SUBSTANCE WAS 1.27 OZS. WHICH MEETS THE CRITERIA FOR AN UNLAWFUL USE OF WEAPONS CHARGE DUE TO THE FACT THAT HAD WEIGHED IN AT OVER ONE-QUARTER OUNCE.
