These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.


Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when complied without possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: [publicaccess@atg.state.il.us](mailto:publicaccess@atg.state.il.us). You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

Report Narrative ON 05-15-16 AT APPROXIMATELY 1404 HOURS, THE R/O AND OFC. MELONE #521 WERE DISPATCHED TO THE AREA OF IL. RT. 83 AND FOSTER FOR THE ROLLING DOMESTIC BATTERY THAT JUST OCCURRED. THE R/O WAS ADVISED BY DISPATCH THAT THE VEHICLE PULLED INTO THE THORTON'S GAS STATION PARKING LOT, 601 N. IL. RT. 83, AND THE MALE SUBJECT WAS GRABBED BY THE FEMALE. OFC. MELONE WAS THE FIRST TO ARRIVE ON SCENE, AND THEN THE R/O ARRIVED AND OFFICERS CAME INTO CONTACT WITH THE VICTIM, JOSE G. RUIZ, [REDACTED], WHO STATED HE WAS BATTERED BY HIS GIRLFRIEND, [REDACTED], F/W, [REDACTED], WHILE DRIVING NORTH BOUND IN HIS VEHICLE ON IL. RT. 83.

THE R/O SPOKE WITH RUIZ WHO STATED IN SUMMARY, RUIZ, HIS GIRLFRIEND [REDACTED], AND RUIZ NINE YEAR OLD SON, WENT TO BREAKFAST IN FRANKLIN PARK. WHILE AT BREAKFAST, [REDACTED], ACCUSED RUIZ OF LOOKING AT OTHER FEMALES WHILE INSIDE THE RESTAURANT. RUIZ STATED A VERBAL ARGUMENT OCCURRED BETWEEN RUIZ AND [REDACTED]. RUIZ STATED AFTER LEAVING THE RESTAURANT RUIZ ENTERED HIS SILVER IN COLOR, 2002 HONDA VAN, IL. REGISTRATION [REDACTED], WITH [REDACTED] SITTING IN THE FRONT PASSENGER SEAT, AND RUIZ SON SITTING IN THE BACK SEAT. RUIZ STATED THE VERBAL ARGUMENT CONTINUED WHILE DRIVING [REDACTED] HOME TO [REDACTED]. RUIZ STATED WHILE TRAVELING IN THE AREA OF NORTH BOUND IL. RT. 83 AND FOSTER AVE, [REDACTED] WITH A CLOSED HAND, STRUCK RUIZ IN THE RIGHT EYE. THE R/O COULD SEE THAT RUIZ EYE WAS RED IN THE RIGHT CORNER OF HIS EYE. RUIZ REFUSED MEDICAL TREATMENT.

THE R/O SPOKE WITH [REDACTED] WHO STATED IN SUMMARY THAT, [REDACTED], HER BOYFRIEND RUIZ, AND RUIZ NINE YEAR OLD SON, WENT TO BREAKFAST IN FRANKLIN PARK. [REDACTED] STATED THAT, WHILE AT BREAKFAST, RUIZ BEGAN LOOKING AT OTHER FEMALES INSIDE THE RESTAURANT, WHICH CAUSED [REDACTED] TO BECOME UPSET. A VERBAL ARGUMENT OCCURRED BETWEEN [REDACTED] AND RUIZ, AND RUIZ EXITED THE RESTAURANT WITH HIS SON AND GOT INTO THE CAR, ALMOST LEAVING [REDACTED] BEHIND AT THE RESTAURANT. [REDACTED] STATED THAT, SHE ENTERED THE FRONT PASSENGER SEAT, WITH RUIZ DRIVING, AND RUIZ SON IN THE BACKSEAT. [REDACTED] STATED THAT, RUIZ WAS CALLING HER NAMES AND SWEARING AT HER IN FRONT OF HIS SON. [REDACTED] STATED THAT, WHILE RUIZ WAS DRIVING THE CAR, IN THE AREA OF NORTH BOUND IL. RT. 83 AND FOSTER AVE, SHE SWUNG HER OPEN LEFT HAND AT RUIZ, WHICH STRUCK RUIZ IN THE RIGHT EYE. [REDACTED] STATED THAT, RUIZ PULLED INTO THE THORTON'S GAS STATION PARKING LOT, TELLING [REDACTED] THAT SHE WAS GOING TO JAIL FOR HITTING HIM, AND HE THEN CALLED THE POLICE.

THE R/O ADVISED [REDACTED] THAT SHE WAS UNDER ARREST FOR DOMESTIC BATTERY. THE R/O HANDCUFFED [REDACTED], DOUBLE LOCKED, AND CHECKED FOR TIGHTNESS.

OFC. MELONE PROVIDED RUIZ WITH A ILLINOIS DOMESTIC VIOLENCE ACT-VICTIM INFORMATION FORM.

THE R/O TRANSPORTED [REDACTED] TO THE BENSENVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT WHERE SHE WAS PROCESSED, CHARGED WITH TWO COUNTS OF DOMESTIC BATTERY, AND PLACED INTO CELL #5.

ON 05-15-16 AT APPROXIMATELY 1715 HOURS, OFC. VALOIS #562 TRANSPORTED [REDACTED] TO THE DUPAGE COUNTY JAIL, WHERE SHE WAS RELEASED INTO THEIR CUSTODY.

ON 05-15-16 AT APPROXIMATELY 1920 HOURS, THE R/O SPOKE WITH TINA FROM THE FAMILY ADVOCACY CENTER TO INFORM THEM OF THE DOMESTIC BATTERY REPORT.
