Dear Ms. Rivera:

I am pleased to help you with your August 11, 2016 Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"). Your request was received by the Village of Bensenville on August 11, 2016. You requested copies of the items indicated below:

"Any and all police reports for my client Francisco Mercado-Mata from 2001-2005 for battery."

After a search of Village files, the following documents are enclosed to fulfill your request:

- 1) Village of Bensenville Police Reports responsive to your request. (14 pgs.)

These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when complied without possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

ON 11-22-05, AT ABOUT 1731 HRS, R/O WAS DISPATCHED TO [REDACTED] FOR A REPORT OF DOMESTIC BATTERY. UPON ARRIVAL, R/O SPOKE TO THE VICTIM WHO RELATED THAT HER LIVE IN BOYFRIEND, FRANCISCO MERCADO, HAD GRABBED HER BY THE THROAT, PUNCHED HER IN THE FACE ON HER LEFT CHEEK AND KICKED HER LEFT LEG. MERCADO FLED FROM THE RESIDENCE WHEN FLORES CALLED THE POLICE. FLORES WAS NOT ABLE TO TELL R/O WHY MERCADO MIGHT HAVE HIT HER. ON APRIL 30, 2006 AT APPROXIMATELY 2000HRS THE REPORTING OFFICER (R/O) MANDZIARA #512 WAS ASSIGNED TO ██████████ FOR THE SUSPICIOUS PERSON (DELAYED).

UPON ARRIVAL THE R/O SPOKE TO THE COMPLAINANT AND VICTIM FRANCISCO MERCADO. MERCADO STATED THAT SUSPECT ALVINO MEJIA HAD DROPPED OFF ██████████ PHOTOGRAPH TO HIS WIFE DENIA FLORES.

THE R/O HAS HAD PRIOR CONTACT REGARDING ALL PARTIES INVOLVED (2006-3915).

MERCADO STATED THAT HE ALSO ATTEMPTED TO CONTACT FLORES ON HER CELLULAR TELEPHONE ██████████ MERCADO STATED THAT HE ANSWERED THE TELEPHONE WHEN THE NUMBER ██████████ APPEARED ON THE SCREEN. MERCADO STATED THAT THE CALLER WAS MEJIA, WHO STATED THAT HE WAS GOING TO KILL MERCADO. MERCADO STATED THAT HE ATTEMPTED TO CONTACT MEJIA, HOWEVER MEJIA WOULD HAND UP THE TELEPHONE.

MERCADO STATED THAT HE DOES NOT KNOW WHERE MEJIA IS RESIDING, AFTER HE MADE HIM LEAVE HIS RESIDENCE.

FLORES STATED THAT MEJIA COMES TO THE RESIDENCE WHEN MERCADO IS AT WORK, HOWEVER SHE DOES NOT LET HIM INSIDE THE RESIDENCE.

THE R/O ADVISED MERCADO AND FLORES TO CONTACT POLICE IMMEDIATELY IF MEJIA IS AT THE RESIDENCE.

THE R/O LEFT A MESSAGE ON THE TELEPHONE THAT MERCADO ADVISED THE R/O WAS MEJIA'S ON APRIL 30, 2006 AT APPROXIMATELY 2130HRS.

ON WEDNESDAY, AT 1121 HRS, 05-03-06, R/I MET WITH SUSPECT, ALVINO MEJIA, M/H ██████████, IN THE LOBBY OF THE BENSENVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

R/I CONDUCTED A NON - CUSTODIAL INTERVIEW WITH SUSPECT / MEJIA IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE BENSENVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT. MEJIA CLAIMED HE SPOKE NO ENGLISH. R/I REQUESTED THE ASSISTANCE OF RECORDS CLERK VALLE #546 TO TRANSLATE SPANISH. R/I AT FIRST TRIED TO DETERMINE THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN MEJIA AND FRANCISCO MERCADO AND HIS WIFE, DENIA FLORES. R/I WAS INFORMED THROUGH TRANSLATION, SPANISH TO ENGLISH, THAT MEJIA USED TO LIVE WITH MERCADO AND FLORES. R/I ASKED MEJIA IF HE KNEW THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN MERCADO AND FLORES. R/I WAS INFORMED THAT MEJIA WAS UNDER THE IMPRESSION THAT MERCADO WAS NOT MARRIED TO FLORES, THEY WERE ONLY LIVING TOGETHER. R/I THEN ASKED MEJIA IF HE CALLED MERCADO AND THREATENED TO KILL MERCADO. MEJIA DENIED HE EVER CALLED MERCADO. R/I ASKED MEJIA ABOUT THE LETTER HE REPORTEDLY GAVE TO MERCADO WITH HIS PICTURE. MEJIA DENIED EVER GIVING A LETTER OR PICTURES TO MERCADO. R/I ASKED VALLE #546 TO EXPLAIN IN GREAT DETAIL THE PROCESS IN RECOVERING FINGERPRINTS FROM PAPER. R/I ASKED VALLE #546, TO ASK MEJIA IF HIS FINGERPRINTS WOULD BE FOUND ON THE LETTER. MEJIA ADMITTED HIS FINGERPRINTS WOULD BE FOUND ON THE LETTER BUT THE LETTER WAS MEANT TO BE GIVEN TO FLORES. R/I INQUIRED IF THE LETTER WAS A LOVE LETTER. VALLE #546 INFORMED THIS R/I THAT MEJIA TOLD HER IN SPANISH THE LETTER WAS A TYPE OF LOVE LETTER. R/I THEN ASKED VALLE #546 TO GO INTO GREAT DETAIL ABOUT HOW THIS R/I COULD OBTAIN A GRAND JURY SUBPOENA FOR MERCADO'S TELEPHONE RECORDS. R/I SHOWED MEJIA WHAT THE SUBPOENA'ED PHONE RECORDS WOULD LOOK LIKE AND ASKED VALLE #546 TO EXPLAIN THE ITEMIZED RECORDS. MEJIA THEN TOLD VALLE #546 THAT HE HAD TRIED TO CALL FLORES BUT MERCADO ANSWERED THE TELEPHONE. MERCADO STARTED TO ARGUE WITH HIM AND HE MIGHT HAVE THREATENED HIM. MEJIA CLAIMED HE DID NOT RECALL EXACTLY WHAT HE SAID ON THE PHONE WITH MERCADO. R/I STOPPED THE INTERVIEW AND WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF VALLE #546 EXPLAINED TO MEJIA HE IS NOT TO CALL EITHER FLORES OR MERCADO ON THE TELEPHONE OR TO HAVE CONTACT WITH THEM AT THEIR RESIDENCE.
