These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.


Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

Report Narrative THE [REDACTED] PROPERTY CONTAINS A RENTAL-PAY BY THE WEEK FLOPHOUSE KNOWN AS "THE CABOOSE". THE PROPERTY IS LOCATED ON THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF GREEN STREET AND MARION COURT. A SMALL POORLY LIT PARKING LOT IS LOCATED BEHIND (SOUTH) OF THE BUILDING. WITHIN THE PAST SEVERAL WEEKS ONE OF THE TENANTS SET UP A MAKESHIFT TENT IN THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE LOT BETWEEN THE CHAIN LINK DUMPSTER ENCLOSURE AND THE FENCED SOUTH LOT LINE. AN AGED WOOD DINING TABLE WITH SEVERAL PLASTIC CHAIRS HAD BEEN PLACED IN THE SAME AREA NEXT TO THE TENT.

THE TENANT WHO SET UP THE TENT WAS IDENTIFIED AS JAMES A WILLIAMS [REDACTED]. OVER THE PAST SEVERAL YEARS WILLIAMS HAS HAD MULTIPLE CONTACTS WITH THE POLICE AND IS WELL KNOWN TO R/O AND OTHER MEMBERS OF THE BENSENVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT. WILLIAMS' INTERACTIONS WITH POLICE HAVE WIDELY RANGED FROM COOPERATIVE AND FRIENDLY TO UNTRUSTING TO SCARED AND EVEN HOSTILE. WILLIAMS IS A LARGER SIZED MAN (APPROX: 5'11" / 300 lbs) AND SUFFERS FROM THE MENTAL ILLNESS SCHIZOPHRENIA. R/O HAS SPOKEN WITH WILLIAMS ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS OVER THE PAST YEAR. DURING THIS TIME R/O LEARNED WILLIAMS HAD STOPPED TAKING COURT ORDERED MEDICATION TO HELP TREAT HIS SCHIZOPHRENIA. DURING THE MOST RECENT INTERACTIONS, R/O NOTICED A STEADY DECLINE IN FRIENDLINESS AND OBSERVED WILLIAMS TO BE MORE PARANOID OF PEOPLE AND GOVERNMENT AGENCIES. AMONG OTHER TOPICS, WILLIAMS WOULD CONTINUALLY ASK R/O ABOUT HIS RIGHT TO DEFEND HIMSELF IF ATTACKED.

ON 02 SEPTEMBER 2016 AT APPROXIMATELY 2105 HOURS, BENSENVILLE POLICE WERE DISPATCHED TO THE REAR PARKING LOT OF THE CABOOSE FLOPHOUSE [REDACTED] FOR AN AGGRAVATED ASSAULT. DISPATCH ADVISED A LARGE INTOXICATED HEAVY SET WHITE MALE WAS THREATENING TO "KILL" PEOPLE PASSING THROUGH THE REAR LOT. THE SUBJECT WAS REPORTED TO BE ARMED WITH A METAL PIPE AND "NINJA" TYPE THROWING STAR WEAPONS. THE OFFENDER WAS CLOTHED IN A LEATHER COAT / YOGA TYPE PANTS AND LAST SEEN STANDING NEXT TO THE MAKESHIFT TENT PITCHED IN THE LOT. THE COMPLAINANT WAS IDENTIFIED ONLY AS "JERRY" WITH A TELEPHONE NUMBER [REDACTED].

R/O, OFFICER CALIENDO #11, OFFICER VALOIS #62, AND OFFICER KOTLEWSKI #61 INITIALLY RESPONDED TO THE CALL FOR SERVICE. DETECTIVE SERGEANT ZODROW #08, DETECTIVE PTAK #32, AS WELL AS TWO CITY OF WOOD DALE POLICE OFFICERS RESPONDED TO THE CALL LATER WHEN ADDITIONAL BACK-UP UNITS WERE REQUESTED.

R/O ARRIVED ON SCENE JUST AFTER OFFICER CALIENDO #11, OFFICER VALOIS #62, AND OFFICER KOTLEWSKI #61. R/O IMMEDIATELY IDENTIFIED WILLIAMS STANDING IN THE REAR SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE LOT (NEXT TO THE PITCHED TENT / DINNING TABLE). WILLIAMS FIT BOTH THE BROADCAST PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION AND WAS WEARING CLOTHING DESCRIBED BY THE COMPLAINANT. WILLIAMS WAS ALONE AND NO OTHER SUBJECTS WERE PRESENT IN THE LOT. WILLIAMS WAS HOLDING HIS LEFT ARM STRAIGHT OUT TO HIS SIDE. WILLIAMS WAS HOLDING AN OBJECT IN HIS LEFT HAND WHICH WAS LATER IDENTIFIED AS A STEEL REBAR ROD (APPROXIMATELY 3' IN LENGTH X 1/2" DIAMETER). WILLIAMS APPEARED TO BE IN AN AGITATED STATE AND WAS SPEAKING UNINTELLIGIBLY AT AN EXTREMELY FAST PACE.

AS RESPONDING OFFICERS APPROACHED WILLIAMS ON FOOT THROUGH THE PARKING LOT, WILLIAMS SAT DOWN IN A PLASTIC LAWN CHAIR AT THE DINNING TABLE. WILLIAMS WAS NOW POSITIONED FACING NORTH BEHIND THE SAID TABLE WITH HIS BACK TO THE SOUTH FENCE LINE. OFFICERS APPROACHED WILLIAMS AT A SLOW PACE AND ONCE AT THE TABLE KEPT DISTANCE AS NOT TO INCITE HIM. WHILE SEATED WILLIAMS CONTINUED TO HOLD THE STEEL REBAR OUT IN HIS LEFT HAND AS PREVIOUSLY NOTED. AT THIS TIME R/O OBSERVED SEVERAL OPENED LIQUOR BOTTLES SET ON TOP OF THE TABLE.

WILLIAMS WAS SPEAKING NON STOP AND JUMPING FROM TOPIC TO TOPIC TO A POINT WHERE HE WAS MOSTLY

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UNINTELLIGIBLE. R/O MADE OUT SOME OF WHAT WILLIAMS WAS ATTEMPTING TO COMMUNICATE. WILLIAMS RELATED HE HAD A RIGHT TO BE ON THE PROPERTY AND TO DEFEND HIMSELF. WILLIAMS STATED OFFICERS WERE TRESPASSING AND WANTED THEM TO LEAVE. R/O ATTEMPTED TO INTERVENE AND INITIATE A CONVERSATION WITH WILLIAMS. WILLIAMS SPOKE OVER R/O AS IF R/O WAS NOT SPEAKING. WILLIAMS BARELY ACKNOWLEDGED R/O AND MOSTLY AVOIDED EYE CONTACT WHEN HE DID. OTHER OFFICERS ALSO ATTEMPTED TO COMMUNICATE WITH WILLIAMS WITH THE SAME RESULT. WILLIAMS BEHAVIOR MADE IT IMPOSSIBLE TO INITIATE OR MAINTAIN ANY TYPE OF DIALOG.

TO THIS POINT VERBAL COMMUNICATION WAS CLEARLY NOT WORKING. AFTER SEVERAL MINUTES OF FAILED NEGOTIATIONS WILLIAMS ONLY APPEARED TO BECOME MORE AGITATED. WILLIAMS IGNORED MULTIPLE COMMANDS TO DROP THE PIECE OF STEEL REBAR AND R/O FELT THE ENCOUNTER WAS ESCALATING. R/O'S FIRST PRIORITY WAS TO DISARM WILLIAMS FOR BOTH HIS SAFETY AND THE SAFETY OF OFFICERS PRESENT. R/O FELT OFFICERS HAD A TACTICAL ADVANTAGE OVER WILLIAMS WHILE SEATED AND FEARED WILLIAMS WOULD SOON BECOME FRUSTRATED TO A POINT WHERE HE WOULD STAND WITH THE WEAPON IN HIS HAND. R/O REALIZED WILLIAMS WOULD BE MUCH LESS POWERFUL IN THE SEATED POSITION IF HE DECIDED TO SWING THE REBAR TO "DEFEND" HIMSELF AND WOULD FORCE A VOLATILE SITUATION IF HE STOOD.

WILLIAMS WAS SEATED IN A VERY CONFINED SPACE BEHIND THE WOOD TABLE. THE DEPLOYMENT OF A DEPARTMENT ISSUED TASER WAS NOT A LOGICAL OPTION. IT WAS DECIDED THE ONLY OPTION WAS TO PHYSICALLY DISARM WILLIAMS BEFORE HE STOOD. R/O MOVED IN ON WILLIAMS TO HIS LEFT AND OFFICER KOTLEWSKI #61 TO HIS RIGHT. R/O REACHED OUT, GRABBED HOLD OF, AND REMOVED THE PIECE OF STEEL REBAR FROM WILLIAMS' HAND. IN THE SAME MOTION WILLIAMS WAS FORCED BACKWARDS CAUSING THE REAR PLASTIC LEGS OF THE CHAIR TO BREAK. WILLIAMS FELL BACKWARDS TO THE GROUND LEAVING A PORTION OF HIS LEGS ELEVATED ON THE CHAIR. R/O IMMEDIATELY TOOK A SIDE MOUNT (WILLIAMS' LEFT SIDE).

WILLIAMS FIRST APPEARED TO BE STARTLED BY THE ACTION THEN SUDDENLY BECAME WHAT R/O WOULD DESCRIBE AS ENRAGED, SCARED, AND CONFUSED AT THE SAME TIME. R/O IMMEDIATELY ATTEMPTED VERBALLY CALM WILLIAMS TO NO EFFECT. WILLIAMS WAS PANICKED AND ATTEMPTED TO PUSH / PRESS R/O OFF OF HIM. WILLIAMS WAS PHYSICALLY STRONG AND EXTREMELY POWERFUL. R/O WAS FORCED TO PIN WILLIAMS' HEAD TO THE GROUND (TO HIS RIGHT) WITH THE USE OF R/O'S FOREARM. WILLIAMS BEGAN TO STRUGGLE, PUSH, AND KICK HIS FEET EVEN MORE TO BREAK FREE OF THE HOLD.

WILLIAMS WAS PUSHING UP ON R/O AND FLAILING HIS BODY WITH SUCH FORCE THAT R/O FEARED WILLIAMS WAS GOING TO BREAK FREE OF THE SIDE MOUNT. THE POSITION OF WILLIAMS' BODY, HIS POWERFUL VIOLENT MOVEMENTS, AND THE EXTREMELY CLOSE QUARTERS MADE IT DIFFICULT IF NOT IMPOSSIBLE FOR ASSISTING OFFICERS TO EFFECTIVELY GRAB HOLD OF WILLIAMS. R/O BELIEVED THAT IF WILLIAMS WAS ABLE TO GET TO HIS FEET IT WOULD DRASTICALLY INCREASE THE LIKELY HOOD OF INJURY TO BOTH WILLIAMS AND OFFICERS PRESENT. ASSISTING OFFICERS DEPLOYED THEIR TASERS IN ATTEMPT TO STUN AND GAIN COMPLIANCE FROM WILLIAMS. WILLIAMS WAS TASED SEVERAL TIMES WHICH HAD LITTLE TO NO EFFECTIVENESS (REFER TO SUPPLEMENTAL REPORTS SUBMITTED BY OFFICER CALIENDO #11 AND OFFICER KOTLEWSKI #61). WILLIAMS WAS NOT LOSING ANY STRENGTH AND ASSISTANCE WAS REQUESTED FROM THE NEIGHBORING CITY OF WOOD DALE. OFFICER VALOIS #62 AND OFFICER KOTLEWSKI #61 WERE EVENTUALLY ABLE TO PARTIALLY RESTRAIN AND HANDCUFF WILLIAMS IN THE FRONT UTILIZING TWO SETS OF EXTENDED HANDCUFFS.

DETECTIVE SERGEANT ZODROW #05 AND DETECTIVE PTAK #32 ARRIVED ON SCENE A SHORT TIME LATER. THE BROKEN CHAIR WAS REMOVED FROM UNDERNEATH WILLIAMS AND HIS LEGS WERE STRAIGHTENED. DURING THE PROCESS WILLIAMS WAS ROLLED HALF WAY TO HIS RIGHT SIDE. R/O KEPT A MODIFIED SIDE MOUNT, DETECTIVE PTAK #32 TOOK CONTROL OF WILLIAMS' HIPS, AND OFFICER VALOIS #62 WENT DOWN TO CONTROL WILLIAMS' MIDDLE TO LOWER LEGS. WILLIAMS CONTINUED TO VIOLENTLY THRASH HIS BODY TO ESCAPE. AT WHICH TIME WILLIAMS BUCKED OFFICER VALOIS #62 OFF HIS LEGS. OFFICER VALOIS #62 LOST HER BALANCE AND REACHED FORWARD WITH HER LEFT HAND TO CATCH HERSELF. AT WHICH TIME HER LEFT HAND CAME DOWN ON A BROKEN PIECE OF GLASS LYING IN THE PARKING LOT. OFFICER VALOIS #62 RECEIVED A LACERATION TO HER HAND AS A RESULT OF THE SAID ACTION. RESPONDING BENSENVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT PARAMEDICS TREATED AND TRANSPORTED OFFICER VALOIS #62 TO ELMHURST MEMORIAL HOSPITAL. OFFICER VALOIS #62 RECEIVED IMMEDIATE MEDICAL CARE IN THE EMERGENCY ROOM WHERE SHE RECEIVED 8 STITCHES TO CLOSE THE WOUND ON THE SIDE OF HER LEFT HAND. TWO DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHS OF OFFICER VALOIS' #62 INJURY WERE TAKEN. COPIES OF THE PHOTOGRAPHS WERE BOTH ENTERED INTO EVIDENCE AND ATTACHED TO THE ORIGINAL CASE REPORT.

DURING THE CONFUSION, WILLIAMS REACHED UP AND GRABBED HOLD OF R/O'S METAL FLASHLIGHT. WILLIAMS FIRMLY GRASPED THE FLASHLIGHT WITH BOTH HANDS AND REMOVED IT FROM R/O'S RIGHT HAND. WILLIAMS IGNORED ORDERS TO RELEASE THE LIGHT. R/O'S FLASHLIGHT WAS APPROXIMATELY 12 INCHES LONG AND 1" DIAMETER. THE SITUATION POSED A SERIOUS SITUATION AS WILLIAMS WAS NOW HOLDING AN IMPACT WEAPON IN HIS HANDS. WILLIAMS WAS STILL BEING HELD DOWN BY R/O'S RIGHT FOREARM LEAVING ONLY R/O'S LEFT HAND TO RETRIEVE THE FLASHLIGHT. R/O WAS UNABLE TO OVER POWER WILLIAMS AND REMOVE THE FLASHLIGHT FROM HIS HANDS. R/O IMMEDIATELY RESORTED TO A STUNNING TECHNIQUE. UTILIZING THE UPPER SOFT PART OF R/O'S RIGHT ELBOW, R/O DELIVERED A SERIES OF SIX BLOWS TO THE SIDE OF WILLIAMS' HEAD. THE SAID ACTION APPEARED TO STUN WILLIAMS ENOUGH WHERE R/O WAS ABLE TO WRESTLE THE FLASHLIGHT OUT OF HIS HANDS AND TOSS IT OUT OF REACH.

WILLIAMS NEVER STOPPED ATTEMPTING TO BREAK FREE OF OFFICERS HOLDING HIM TO THE GROUND ALTHOUGH HE WAS SLOWING DOWN AS TIME PASSED. WILLIAMS STILL HAD A TREMENDOUS AMOUNT OF ENERGY AND IT WAS

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DECIDED HE WOULD NOT BE MOVED UNTIL RESPONDING PARAMEDICS ISSUED A SEDATIVE. WILLIAMS WAS ISSUED A SEDATIVE VIA SYRINGE AND AFTER SEVERAL MINUTES WILLIAMS BEGAN TO CALM HIS BODY TO A POINT WHERE IT WAS SAFE TO MOVE HIM. DETECTIVE PTAK #32 AND R/O RAISED WILLIAMS TO HIS FEET AND ESCORTED HIM ONTO AN AWAITING AMBULANCE WHERE HE WAS SECURED TO THE STRETCHER BY THE USE OF SOFT RESTRAINTS. OFFICER KOTLEWSKI #61 RODE WITH BENSENVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT PARAMEDICS AS THEY TRANSPORTED WILLIAMS TO ELMHURST MEMORIAL HOSPITAL FOR A PSYCHOLOGICAL EVALUATION.

DETECTIVE PTAK #32 ASSISTED R/O IN RECOVERING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS FROM THE SCENE:
- ONE STEEL REBAR ROD (38" LONG X 1/2" DIAMETER) - COLLECTED FROM THE LEFT HAND OF WILLIAMS
- THREE 3" SHURIKEN (aka CHINESE / NINJA THROWING STARS) - RECOVERED FROM ON TOP OF THE WOOD TABLE
- ONE FOLDING 3" BLADE POCKET KNIFE - RECOVERED FROM ON TOP OF THE WOOD TABLE
- TWO ALUMINUM "SHREDDERS" CONTAINING SUSPECT CANNABIS RESIDUAL - RECOVERED FROM ON TOP OF THE WOOD TABLE
- ONE PLASTIC "ONE HITTER" - RECOVERED FROM ON TOP OF THE WOOD TABLE
- THREE GLASS SMOKING DEVICES WITH AN UNKNOWN BURNT RESIDUAL SUBSTANCE - RECOVERED FROM ON TOP OF THE WOOD TABLE
- ONE AWS DIGITAL SCALE - RECOVERED FROM ON TOP OF THE WOOD TABLE
- ONE EMPTY ALUMINUM MATCH CANISTER - RECOVERED FROM ON TOP OF THE WOOD TABLE
- NINETY-EIGHT NEW 2"X2" ZIPLOC TYPE BAGGIES WITH "S" PRINT - RECOVERED FROM ON TOP OF THE WOOD TABLE
- ONE POUCH WITH ATTACHED KEY CHAIN CONTAINING: WILLIAMS' ILLINOIS DRIVER'S LICENSE (W452-4417-4320) AND TWENTY-TWO 2"X2" ZIPLOC TYPE BAGGIES - RECOVERED FROM ON TOP OF THE WOOD TABLE

THE SAID LISTED ITEMS WERE LATER TAGGED AND ENTERED INTO EVIDENCE BY DETECTIVE PTAK #32. THE FOUR BARBS FROM THE TWO TASER DEPLOYMENTS (OFFICER CALIENDO #11 / OFFICER KOTLEWSKI #61) WERE LATER RECOVERED FROM ELMHURST MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AND ALSO PLACED INTO EVIDENCE BY DETECTIVE PTAK #32.

CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS ARE PENDING:

- 1) AGGRAVATED ASSAULT (720 ILCS 5/12-2)
- 2) RESISTING A PEACE OFFICER (720 ILCS 5/31-1)
- 3) AGGRAVATED BATTERY TO A POLICE OFFICER (INJURY TO OFFICER VALOIS #62) - (720 ILCS 5/12-3.05)

R/O WILL CONTACT A DuPAGE COUNTY ASSISTANT STATE'S ATTORNEY ON THE NEXT BUSINESS DAY (06 SEPTEMBER 2016) TO SEEK DIRECTION WITH APPROPRIATE CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS AND DISCUSS THE ELIGIBILITY OF WILLIAMS' ENTRY INTO THE DuPAGE COUNTY MENTAL ILLNESS COURT ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM (MICAP).

AS OF 05 SEPTEMBER 2016, WILLIAMS HAS BEEN TRANSFERRED FROM ELMHURST MEMORIAL HOSPITAL TO AN INPATIENT PSYCHIATRIC TREATMENT FACILITY AT [REDACTED]. NOTHING FURTHER AT THIS TIME.
