Dear Ms. Wendelken:

I am pleased to help you with your September 19, 2016 Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"). Your request was received by the Village of Bensenville on September 19, 2016. You requested copies of the items indicated below:

"169062."

After a search of Village files, the following documents are enclosed to fulfill your request:

- 1) Village of Bensenville Crime Report No. BV16009062.1. (3 pgs.)

These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when complied without possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

Report Narrative ON 9-08-2016 AT APPROXIMATELY 1630HRS, R/O WAS DISPATCHED TO [REDACTED] FOR THE REPORT OF A RUSE BURGLARY. UPON ARRIVAL R/O SPOKE TO VITO CAMPAGNA, M/W, [REDACTED], WHO INFORMED R/O THAT WHILE SITTING IN HIS GARAGE, HE WAS APPROACHED BY A F/H WALKING FROM THE NORTH AND INTO HIS GARAGE. CAMPAGNA FURTHER INFORMED R/O THAT THE F/H BEGAN TO ASK HIM QUESTIONS ABOUT TOOLS LOCATED INSIDE THE GARAGE AND WHERE TO BUY THE SAME TOOLS. CAMPAGNA STATED THAT THE F/H SAT IN A LAWN CHAIR NEXT TO HIM AND BEGAN TO ASK FURTHER QUESTIONS. CAMPAGNA INFORMED R/O THAT THE ENTIRE TIME THE F/H HAD ENGAGED HIM, SHE HAD A CELL PHONE HELD UP TO HER EAR. THE F/H PERSISTENTLY BEGAN TO ASK TO GO INSIDE THE HOUSE BUT CAMPAGNA REFUSED.

THE F/H THEN LEFT SOUTHBOUND ON HAWTHORNE FROM CAMPAGNA'S RESIDENCE. THE F/H WAS DESCRIBED AS WEARING A GRAY BALL CAP, A WHITE BLOUSE AND BLUE JEANS.

CAMPAGNA ENTERED HIS RESIDENCE AND LOCATED THE SOUTH FACING SLIDING DOOR TO BE OPEN. CAMPAGNA FURTHER INFORMED R/O THAT HE CHECKED THE DOCUMENT SAFE IN HIS MASTER BEDROOM CLOSET TO FIND IT OPEN AND EMPTY. INSIDE THE SAFE WAS \$8000.00 IN U.S.C AND \$1500.00 IN SAVINGS BONDS. CAMPAGNA THEN CALLED THE POLICE. CAMPAGNA BELIEVES THAT WHILE HE WAS DISTRACTED, AN ACCOMPLICE ENTERED THE RESIDENCE BY PUSHING AGAINST THE SLIDING GLASS DOOR IN AN UPWARD MOTION DISENGAGING THE LOCK. THE ACCOMPLICE ENTERED THE RESIDENCE AND REMOVED THE MONEY.

CAMPAGNA SHOWED R/O WHERE THE SLIDING GLASS DOOR WAS. R/O OBSERVED TWO SMUDGE MARKS UPON THE GLASS APPROXIMATELY 10in IN LENGTH. R/O DID NOT OBSERVE ANY LATENT PRINTS. R/O WAS NOT ABLE TO OBTAIN A GOOD PHOTOGRAPH OF THE SMUDGE MARKS DUE TO THE EXCESSIVE GLARE OF THE SUN. R/O OBSERVED THE SLIDING GLASS DOOR TO BE DESIGNED TO SIT ON THE EXTERIOR OF THE TWO SLIDING PORTIONS. R/O RECOMMENDED THAT CAMPAGNA OBTAIN SMALL RUBBER BUMPERS SO THAT THE DOOR COULD NOT BE MOVED IN AN UPWARD MOTION DISENGAGING THE LOCK.

CAMPAGNA THEN SHOWED R/O WHERE THE SAFE WAS LOCATED. R/O OBSERVED NOTHING OF EVIDENTIARY VALUE UPON THE GLASS DOOR OF THE CLOSET. R/O ALSO DID NOT OBSERVE ANYTHING OF EVIDENTIARY VALUE UPON THE SAFE DUE TO THE SAFES TEXTURED EXTERIOR.

CAMPAGNA HAD CONTACTED HIS BANK IN REFERENCE TO INFORM HIM IMMEDIATELY FOR ANY ACTIVITY ON HIS ACCOUNT AND TO GATHER INFORMATION ABOUT HIS SAVINGS BONDS. R/O REQUESTED CAMPAGNA GIVE R/O COPIES OF ANY BANK PAPERWORK HE IS ABLE TO OBTAIN.

R/O COLLECTED THE WHITE PLASTIC LAWN CHAIR THAT THE F/H HAD SAT IN FOR EVIDENCE. A/O LINKOWSKI #520 TRANSPORTED THE CHAIR TO POLICE HEADQUARTERS FOR PROCESSING.

R/O DID NOT OBSERVE ANY SECURITY SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA.

R/O SPOKE TO THE NEIGHBORS TO CAMPAGNAS IMMEDIATE NORTH AND SOUTH. BOTH RESIDENTS STATED THAT THEY DID NOT SEE OR HEAR ANYTHING.
