These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.


Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when complied without possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

Report Narrative

ON 14 SEPTEMBER 2016 AT APPROXIMATELY 2024 HOURS, R/O WAS DISPATCHED TO A STRONG ARM ROBBERY AT THE POPEYES LOUISIANA KITCHEN RESTAURANT (511 W IRVING PARK ROAD - NORTHEAST CORNER OF IRVING PARK ROAD AND POPPY LANE). DISPATCH ADVISED TWO SUBJECTS WITH COVERED FACES STRUCK AN EMPLOYEE OF THE RESTAURANT, STOLE HIS KEYS, AND FLED IN A WHITE VEHICLE.

UPON ARRIVAL R/O MET WITH VICTIM, [REDACTED] (M/W [REDACTED]), ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE BUILDING. [REDACTED] SPOKE BROKEN ENGLISH AND RELATED THE FOLLOWING IN SUMMARY THROUGH THE AID OF A BILINGUAL (SPANISH / ENGLISH) CO-WORKER - MANAGER, RAQUEL MOYOTL-SANCHEZ (F/W [REDACTED]) AND LATER OFFICER NAVARRO #39.

THE POPEYES LOUISIANA KITCHEN FRANCHISE LOCATION IS OWNED BY A SUBJECT NAMED "ASIF". ASIF OWNS AND OPERATES SEVERAL RESTAURANTS IN THE AREA. [REDACTED] (HEREINAFTER REFERRED [REDACTED] HAS WORKED FOR AND IN RESTAURANTS OWNED BY ASIF FOR CLOSE TO EIGHT YEARS. [REDACTED] HAS WORKED AT THE BENSENVILLE POPEYES LOCATION FOR THE PAST YEAR.

[REDACTED] REGULARLY WORKS 60 TO 70 HOURS A WEEK AT THE BENSENVILLE POPEYES. [REDACTED] WORK HOURS VARY, BUT HE GENERALLY OPENS THE STORE AT 0800 HOURS AND WORKS TILL LATE IN THE EVENING. [REDACTED] HAS BEEN TRUSTED WITH A STORE KEY THAT HE CARRIES ON HIS PERSONAL KEY RING ALONG WITH AN APARTMENT AND VEHICLE KEY. WHEN ARRIVING FOR WORK, [REDACTED] ROUTINELY PARKS HIS PERSONAL VEHICLE (BLACK 1999 HONDA CIVIC SEDAN - ILLINOIS REGISTRATION # [REDACTED]) ON POPPY LANE JUST NORTH OF THE IRVING PARK ROAD INTERSECTION.

ON 14 SEPTEMBER 2016, [REDACTED] WAS SCHEDULED TO WORK TILL 2100 HOURS BUT WAS ADVISED HE COULD LEAVE EARLY BY MOYOTL-SANCHEZ. [REDACTED] CLOCKED OUT AND EXITED THE WEST DOOR OF THE RESTAURANT. [REDACTED] WALKED WESTBOUND THROUGH THE LOT AND ENTERED HIS HONDA (LEGALLY PARKED NORTHBOUND ON POPPY LANE). [REDACTED] BEGAN TO PLACE THE KEY IN THE IGNITION AND CLOSE THE DRIVER DOOR. BEFORE [REDACTED] COULD SHUT THE DOOR, [REDACTED] WAS PHYSICALLY ATTACKED BY TWO ASSAILANTS.

[REDACTED] WAS STRUCK ABOUT THE FACE APPROXIMATELY FOUR TO FIVE TIMES (STRUCK BY BOTH SUBJECTS WITH CLOSED FISTS). [REDACTED] ONLY REMEMBERED HEARING THE OFFENDER(S) SAY "MOTHER FUCKER". [REDACTED] ATTEMPTED TO PUSH THE OFFENDERS BACK AND CLOSE THE VEHICLE DOOR BUT WAS OVERPOWERED BY THE OFFENDERS WHO SUCCESSFULLY HELD THE DOOR OPEN. [REDACTED] REACTED BY RETREATING FURTHER INTO THE VEHICLE TOWARDS THE CENTER / PASSENGER SIDE. THE TWO SUBJECTS LEANED IN THEN PURSUED [REDACTED] INTO THE VEHICLE.

A SHORT STRUGGLE ENSUED, PRIMARILY WITH OFFENDER #1. DURING THE ALTERCATION, [REDACTED] REMEMBERED RIPPING THE COLLAR OF OFFENDER #1'S HOODIE (SWEATSHIRT). WHILE STRUGGLING WITH OFFENDER #1, [REDACTED] FELT OFFENDER #2 GRABBING FOR HIS [REDACTED] FRONT POCKETS. [REDACTED] TWISTED HIS BODY TO PROTECT HIS WALLET (LOCATED IN FRONT RIGHT POCKET). [REDACTED] INADVERTENTLY EXPOSED HIS LEFT FRONT POCKET WHERE HE HAD HIS [REDACTED] CELL PHONE. OFFENDER #2 SUCCESSFULLY REACHED INTO THE EXPOSED FRONT LEFT POCKET AND REMOVED [REDACTED] CELLULAR TELEPHONE.

DURING THE STRUGGLE, [REDACTED] ATTEMPTED BUT WAS UNSUCCESSFUL IN REMOVING A KNIT SKI MASK WORN BY OFFENDER #1. [REDACTED] WAS HOLDING HIS KEY RING IN HIS HAND AND SHOVED THE END OF ONE OF THE KEYS INTO THE SIDE OF OFFENDER #1'S NECK (LEFT). OFFENDER #1 RELEASED HIS HOLD ON [REDACTED], REACHED UP, AND RIPPED THE KEYS FROM [REDACTED] HAND. [REDACTED] TOOK THE OPPORTUNITY TO BREAK FREE OF OFFENDER #1 AND OPENED THEN EXITED THE VEHICLE THROUGH THE FRONT PASSENGER DOOR. AFTER EXITING, [REDACTED] KICKED THE PASSENGER DOOR SHUT AND RAN (EAST) THROUGH THE POPEYES PARKING LOT UP TO THE DRIVE-UP WINDOW TO ALERT

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CO-WORKERS.

REMEMBERED LOOKING BACK AND OBSERVING THE TWO OFFENDERS RUNNING WEST ACROSS POPPY LANE TO A VEHICLE PARKED IN THE LOT OF 201 W IRVING PARK ROAD (NORTHWEST CORNER OF IRVING PARK ROAD AND POPPY LANE). WAS ONLY ABLE TO DESCRIBE THE VEHICLE AS A WHITE PASSENGER CAR. THE OFFENDING VEHICLE WAS PARKED WESTBOUND IN THE AISLE (NOT IN A MARKED PARKING SPACE) AS IF IT WAS STAGED FOR A QUICK EXIT. THE OFFENDERS ENTERED THE VEHICLE AND FLED WESTBOUND FROM THE LOT.

ASSISTING OFFICERS CANVASSED THE 201 W IRVING PARK ROAD PARKING LOT. DETECTIVE SERGEANT ZODROW #08 NOTED A FAINT ODOR OF BURNT CANNABIS IN THE AREA WHERE THE OFFENDING VEHICLE WAS PARKED. OFFICER LaPORTE #59 RECOVERED A POPEYES WORK SHIRT AND APRON LYING IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO WHERE THE OFFENDING VEHICLE WAS PARKED. IDENTIFIED THE FOUND CLOTHING AS HIS. EXPLAINED HE BRINGS A SMALL BACKPACK WITH HIM TO WORK. PLACED THE WORK SHIRT AND APRON INSIDE THE BACKPACK WHEN HE CHANGED OVER AT THE END OF HIS SHIFT. PLACED THE BACKPACK ON THE PASSENGER SEAT OF HIS VEHICLE JUST PRIOR TO THE ROBBERY. SUSPECTS ONE OF THE OFFENDERS REACHED INSIDE AND REMOVED THE CLOTHING FROM THE BACK PACK JUST PRIOR TO FLEEING THE SCENE. WENT THROUGH THE BACK PACK AND DID NOT OBSERVE ANY OTHER ITEMS MISSING FROM WITHIN.

R/O ASKED TO DESCRIBE THE OFFENDERS. EXPLAINED DID NOT SEE THE TWO OFFENDERS WHEN HE EXITED THE RESTAURANT, OR WHILE WALKING TO HIS VEHICLE. NEVER SAW THE OFFENDERS APPROACH THE VEHICLE. WAS SURPRISED AND BATTERED PRIOR TO SEEING EITHER OFFENDER. PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING PHYSICAL DESCRIPTIONS.

OFFENDER #1:

- MALE SUBJECT BELIEVED TO BE WHITE (UNSURE OF RACE)
- 18 YOA (UNSURE OF AGE)
- 5'10" / THIN BUILD
- DRESSED IN A BLACK ZIPPER HOODIE AND BLACK KNIT SKI MASK
- WAS SUBJECT SCRATCHED WITH KEYS

OFFENDER #2:

- MALE SUBJECT BELIEVED TO BE BLACK (UNSURE OF RACE)
- 5'10" / "CHUNKY" BUILD
- 18 YOA (UNSURE OF AGE)
- DRESSED IN A BLACK HOODIE AND BLACK KNIT SKI MASK

R/O ASKED HOW HE ESTIMATED THE OFFENDER'S AGE. RELATED THEY TALKED, CARRIED THEMSELVES, AND STRUCK LIKE TEENAGERS / YOUNG ADULTS. BOTH SUBJECTS SPOKE ENGLISH AND CARRIED AN ODOR OF BURNT CANNABIS. WAS UNSURE IF THE OFFENDERS WERE WEARING GLOVES.

R/O NOTED WAS DRESSED IN WORK ATTIRE AND NOT WEARING JEWELRY. HONDA WAS OLDER AND IN BEATER CONDITION. R/O ASKED IF HE FELT HE WAS SPECIFICALLY TARGETED OR SUSPECTED THE OFFENDERS KNEW HIM. WAS SUSPICIOUS AND FELT THE OFFENDERS MIGHT HAVE KNOWN HIM AND / OR WHAT HOURS HE WORKS. RESIDES IN AN APARTMENT WITH HIS UNCLE IN MELROSE PARK AND DOES NOT HAVE ANY PROBLEMS WITH NEIGHBORS. DOES NOT HAVE ANY CURRENT OR RECENT EX-GIRLFRIENDS. DOES NOT HAVE ANY CHILDREN RESIDING IN THE UNITED STATES. WORKS IN THE BACK KITCHEN AS A COOK AND DOES NOT HAVE CONTACT WITH CUSTOMERS.

STATED HE DOES NOT HAVE ANY CURRENT PROBLEMS AT WORK. R/O ASKED IF HE HAS HAD ANY WORK CONFLICTS IN THE PAST YEAR. EXPLAINED HE DID HAVE A PREVIOUS CONFLICT WITH A MALE / BLACK EMPLOYEE NAMED "RICH". RICH WAS TERMINATED APPROXIMATELY TWO MONTHS AGO AFTER HE WAS CAUGHT STEALING FROM THE RESTAURANT. RICH HELD A MANAGEMENT POSITION AND WAS TRANSFERRED TO THE LOCATION WHEN THE STORE OPENED LATE LAST YEAR. RICH BROUGHT SEVERAL EMPLOYEE-FRIENDS (MALE / BLACKS) WITH HIM TO THE LOCATION DURING THE TRANSFER. THE MAJORITY OF RICH'S CO-WORKER FRIENDS LEFT AT OR ABOUT SAME TIME AS RICH. ADDED RICH WAS CLOSE WITH ONE MALE WHITE EMPLOYEE WHO LEFT AROUND THE SAME TIME AS RICH. DID NOT HAVE A LIST OF NAMES BUT STATED A LIST OF COULD BE OBTAINED THROUGH ASIF. R/O ASKED THE NATURE OF THE CONFLICT. EXPLAINED HE FELT RICH AND OTHER EMPLOYEES WHO LEFT RESENTED FOR BEING QUIET AND A GOOD EMPLOYEE.

R/O LOCATED A BLACK COLORED ZIPPER PULL TAB LYING ON THE PAVEMENT NEXT TO THE HONDA DRIVER DOOR. THE PULL TAB WAS COLLECTED AND LATER ENTERED INTO EVIDENCE. SERGEANT ZODROW #08 PROCESSED HONDA FOR EVIDENCE.

DETECTIVE LARSON #23 LATER RECOVERED THE STOLEN CELLULAR TELEPHONE (WHILE HTC BRAND CELLULAR SMART PHONE - SERIAL # - BOOST MOBILE CARRIER - TELEPHONE #) NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF MYRTLE AND NORTH AVENUE (ELMHURST, IL). THE CELLULAR TELEPHONE WAS DAMAGED WITH A BROKEN TOUCH SCREEN. OFFICER HEPPERT #79 PROCESSED THE TELEPHONE FOR LATENT FINGER PRINTS (TWO LATENT FINGERPRINT CARDS WERE LATER ENTERED INTO EVIDENCE). R/O TOOK SIX (6) DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE TELEPHONE. PRINTED COPIES OF THE DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHS WERE ENTERED INTO EVIDENCE WITH A SEPARATE

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SET ATTACHED TO THE ORIGINAL CASE REPORT. THE CELLULAR TELEPHONE WAS RETURNED TO [REDACTED] AFTER PROCESSING.

THE SET OF KEYS TAKEN FROM [REDACTED] WERE NEVER RECOVERED. [REDACTED] DESCRIBED THE SET OF KEYS AS TWO KEY RINGS INTERTWINED TOGETHER CONSISTING OF THREE KEYS: POPEYES RESTAURANT DOOR KEY, [REDACTED] APARTMENT DOOR KEY, [REDACTED] HONDA VEHICLE KEY.

EXTERIOR SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS (EAST / WEST) WERE LOCATED IN THE 201 N CHURCH ROAD PARKING LOT NEAR WHERE THE OFFENDING VEHICLE WAS PARKED. THE BUSINESS (SU SERVICIO HISPANO INC) WAS CLOSED FOR THE BUSINESS DAY AT THE TIME OF ROBBERY AND FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION. IT IS UNKNOWN AT THE TIME OF THIS REPORT IF THERE IS RECORDED FOOTAGE OF THE OFFENDERS AND OR OFFENDING VEHICLE.

[REDACTED] SUSTAINED INJURIES AS A RESULT OF THE ATTACK. [REDACTED] HAD SWELLING TO THE AREA AROUND HIS RIGHT EYE, A SCRATCH ON HIS NOSE, AND AN ABRASION ON THE LEFT SIDE OF HIS NECK. R/O NOTED THAT THE COLLAR OF [REDACTED] TEE SHIRT WAS STRETCHED OUT AND TORN AS IF SOMEONE WAS VIOLENTLY PULLING ON IT. BENSENVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT PARAMEDICS RESPONDED AND TREATED [REDACTED] ON SCENE. [REDACTED] DECLINED TRANSPORT TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL.

COMPLAINTS WILL BE SIGNED. NOTHING FURTHER AT THIS TIME.
