These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.


Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when complied without possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

Report Narrative **ON 10/25/2016 THE R/O RESPONDED TO THIS PD FOR A REPORT OF INTIMIDATION BY [REDACTED] F/H [REDACTED] WHO STATED THE FOLLOWING IN SUMMARY.**

IN SEPTEMBER 2016 [REDACTED] WAS CONTACTED BY FRANCO OCAMPO, APOLINAR M/H [REDACTED] WHO STATED [REDACTED] NEEDED TO PAY FRANCO OCAMPO \$3,500 USC TO KEEP HER TWO SONS WHO LIVE IN MEXICO SAFE FROM CARTEL CONTRACT KILLERS. [REDACTED] PAID FRANCO OCAMPO ON 09/13/2016 AT A BP GAS STATION IN CHICAGO ON GRAND AVE AT NARRAGANSETT AT APPROXIMATELY 1730 HOURS. 15 DAYS PRIOR TO THIS REPORT [REDACTED] WAS CONTACTED AGAIN BY FRANCO OCAMPO AGAIN FOR A SECOND PAYMENT FOR PROTECTION. FRANCO OCAMPO DEMANDED \$8,000 USC AT THIS TIME AND GAVE [REDACTED] A DEAD LINE OF 10/25/2016 AT 1500 HOURS OR A CONTRACT FOR \$30,000 USC WOULD BE PUT OUT TO KILL HER TWO CHILDREN IN MEXICO.

[REDACTED] AT THIS TIME CONTACTED THE CHICAGO POLICE DEPT. TO REPORT THE CRIME. [REDACTED] STATED THE CHICAGO POLICE DEPT. REFERRED HER TO THE BENSENVILLE PD TO COMPLETE THE REPORT BECAUSE FRANCO OCAMPO LIVED IN BENSENVILLE, IL.

AFTER DISCUSSING THE MATTER WITH [REDACTED] FURTHER THE R/O DETERMINED THAT NO CRIME HAD BEEN COMMITTED WITHIN BENSENVILLE IL AND THAT THE R/O COULD NOT TAKE ACTION BASED ON CURRENT EVIDENCE.

AT THIS TIME OF THE INVESTIGATION OFC. CASILLAS 555 ASSISTED BY INTERVIEWING [REDACTED] IN SPANISH. SEE 555'S SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT.

Report Narrative

At approximately 1430 hours on 10/25/16 Ofc Gilligan requested R/O to help with translation and interviewing of victims/witnesses.

R/O first interviewed Brenda Y Medina-Jimenez f/w [REDACTED] who related the following information in summary:

She met her current boyfriend Apolinar Franco-Ocampo m/w [REDACTED] online back in July of 2015. He moved to the United States and began living with her in February of 2016. At first things were great, but on 05/25/16 while they were living in Northlake he became jealous and slapped her in the face while they were in the car. She exited the car and he followed her continuing to slap her. Her eye became swollen and was purple for a week. She did not call the police because he said it would not happen again. On 07/04/16, while living in Bensenville he asked her not to go to work at Burger King so she did not go. He became angry and violent when her boss called and sent her a text message asking why she did not go to work. He pulled and slapped her, so she ran to her roommate's room and asking for help and to call the police. He entered her roommate's room and pulled Medina-Jimenez out back into their room and said he was going to leave but threatened to kill her and her family in Mexico whenever he found them. In September 2016, she told him that they were going to split up and she was going to take back her SUV. He became angry while they were in the living room and he threw a television at her, while yelling at her. He then got in her face and she believed that he was going to hit or grab her so she left with her son, who was watching. She and her son spent the night at a friend's house and when they returned the next morning he did not let her inside and took her apartment keys. He began taking medication for his nerves and to sleep which seemed to slightly help to calm him down.

In October 2016, her boss from Burger King contacted her regarding a job interview which made Franco-Ocampo angry and violent. He grabbed her by the neck, choking her, and said he was going to kill her. He told her to shut up because if her roommates heard; then he would also kill them. He took her by force to 5 Stars in Villa Park. She told him multiple times that she no longer wanted to be with him and to leave her alone but he refused. She only stayed with him because of fear that he would hurt her son or family, because he told her that she would regret not being with him and cry tears of blood for her son and family. He would get upset when she would leave the house and argue with her; He only wanted her to be in the bedroom with him.

A week ago she found out through her roommate Juana that Franco-Ocampo was extorting money from [REDACTED] f/w [REDACTED]. If she did not give him the money he threatened to kill her children and grandchildren in Mexico and the ones that live with her. On Sunday, he told her that on Tuesday 10/25/16 he was going to get paid at work and they were going to have a lot of money.

He threatened her multiple times that he would kill her, her son and roommates if she screamed or told them anything. Medina-Jimenez provided R/O with a written statement which was later submitted into evidence.

R/O then interviewed [REDACTED] and her husband Marcos J Pereira m/w [REDACTED] who related the following information in summary: On 08/25/16 Apolinar Franco called [REDACTED] to extort her and said she has to give him \$3,500.00 to protect her family in Mexico and Chicago or else they were going to hurt/kill her family. On 09/13/16 at approximately 1730 hours, she took \$3,500.00 to the BP Gas Station on Grand Ave and Narragansett Ave in Chicago and gave it to Franco because she was afraid that her family would be harmed if she did not comply. She recognized Franco to be the boyfriend of her friend Brenda Medina. 15 days ago, she received another call requesting for \$8,000.00 by 10/25/16 and he left her voice and text messages from [REDACTED] of extortion by Franco. Franco said that he was going to send men to her house to collect the money and harm her because she was not answering. [REDACTED] provided R/O with a written statement which was later submitted into evidence.

R/O then interviewed Oscar Ramos-Garcia m/w [REDACTED] who related the following information in summary: He has a child in common with Medina-Jimenez. Franco-Ocampo some how found out the amount of money that he was giving to Medina-Jimenez as child support and Franco-Ocampo said it was too little. Franco-Ocampo said that he and Medina-Jimenez had filed for child support and he could not see his son for 3 months. Franco-Ocampo requested \$30,000.00 from Ramos-Garcia in order to see his son, but then changed the wording saying that Garcia-Ramos was trying to pay him. His son AR told Garcia-Ramos that Franco-Ocampo told him that he is a police officer and needs to check his tablet. Three

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different tablets that Garcia-Ramos bought AR were broken. AR told Garcia-Ramos that Franco-Ocampo got crazy and grabbed Medina-Jimenez by the neck. Garcia-Ramos provided R/O with a written statement which was later submitted into evidence.

R/O advised all parties to seek and obtain an order of protection(oop) as soon as possible. Medina-Jimenez and Juana spent the night at a hotel and were going to Dupage County Judicial Center to obtain the oop. All interviews were video and audio recorded. Nothing further at this time.
