Dear Ms. Vera:

I am pleased to help you with your November 14, 2016 Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"). Your request was received by the Village of Bensenville on November 14, 2016. You requested copies of the items indicated below:

*"16-10583."*

After a search of Village files, the following documents are enclosed to fulfill your request:

- 1) Village of Bensenville Arrest Report No. BV16010583.1. (4 pgs.)

These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when complied without possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: [publicaccess@atg.state.il.us](mailto:publicaccess@atg.state.il.us). You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

ON OCTOBER 16, 2016 AT APPROXIMATELY 0520 HOURS, OFFICERS RESPONDED TO [REDACTED] APT [REDACTED] REGARDING A DOMESTIC BATTERY. UPON ARRIVAL, R/O SPOKE WITH THE VICTIM, [REDACTED] (F/W [REDACTED]) WHO STATED THE FOLLOWING IN SUMMARY:

ON THE ABOVE MENTIONED DATE AT APPROXIMATELY 0345 HOURS, [REDACTED] AND HER HUSBAND, JOAQUIN VERA (M/W [REDACTED]) WERE OUT IN WRIGLEYVILLE SPENDING TIME WITH HIS FRIENDS. SHE STATED JOAQUIN HAD TOO MUCH TO DRINK AND SCOLDED HER IN FRONT OF HIS FRIENDS. WHEN [REDACTED] TOLD HER HUSBAND THAT HE HAD TOO MUCH TO DRINK AND THEY SHOULD GO HOME, HE BECAME UPSET AND SAID THAT HE WANTED TO GO GRAB HIS GUN. NEVER HEARING THOSE WORDS BEFORE FOR NO REASON, [REDACTED] WAS IN FEAR OF HER LIFE AFTER HE MADE THAT STATEMENT. WHEN THEY EVENTUALLY LEFT WRIGLEYVILLE AND ARRIVED AT THEIR RESIDENCE WITH JOAQUIN'S FRIENDS; SHE MENTIONED THAT HER HUSBAND WAS HUNGRY AND ASKED HIS FRIENDS IF THEY WANTED TO GO SOMEWHERE TO EAT. SHE ASKED JOAQUIN'S FRIEND WHO WAS WITH THEM OUTSIDE IN THE PARKING LOT TO KEEP HIM OCCUPIED SO SHE COULD USE THE BATHROOM. WHILE JOAQUIN'S FRIENDS WERE TALKING TO HIM, [REDACTED] WENT INSIDE HER APARTMENT AND HID THE GUN. SHE HID JOAQUIN'S HANDGUN WORRIED THAT HE MIGHT DO SOMETHING TO HER OR HIMSELF. JOAQUIN'S FRIENDS TOLD HIM THAT IT WAS GETTING LATE AND THEY HAD TO LEAVE. WHEN [REDACTED] AND JOAQUIN ENTERED THE APARTMENT, HE TOLD [REDACTED] THAT HE WAS HUNGRY AND WANTED TO GO OUT TO GRAB SOMETHING TO EAT. [REDACTED] TOLD HER HUSBAND THERE WAS PLENTY OF FOOD IN THE KITCHEN, JOAQUIN BECAME UPSET AND BEGAN SHOUTING AT HER AGAIN. SHE STATED JOAQUIN LOOKED FOR HIS GUN WHICH WAS LOCATED IN A DRAWER NEXT TO THE BED ON THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE BEDROOM. WHEN HE OPENED THE DRAWER HE NOTICED THE GUN WAS MISSING. HE BEGAN TO CURSE AT [REDACTED] AND PUSHED/SHOVED HER ONTO THE BED. HE THEN TOLD HER TO PUT THE GUN BACK IN ONE HOUR OR SHE WOULD BE IN TROUBLE. HE WENT INTO THE BATHROOM ENRAGED AND PUNCHED A HOLE IN THE WALL. JOAQUIN THEN LEFT THE RESIDENCE AT WHICH TIME [REDACTED] IMMEDIATELY CALLED THE POLICE. [REDACTED] FURTHER STATED THAT JOAQUIN LEFT THE RESIDENCE IN A GRAY GMC PICK-UP POSSIBLY ENROUTE TO THE WHITE CASTLE ON MANNHEIM OR WENDY'S IN ELMHURST. OFFICERS CHECKED THE AREA WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS.

WHEN R/O ASKED [REDACTED] WHERE SHE HID THE HANDGUN, SHE DIRECTED OFFICERS TO THE BEDROOM CLOSET LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE BEDROOM. UNDERNEATH MULTIPLE LAYERS OF CLOTHES IS WHERE THE H&K 45 (SERIAL [REDACTED]) HANDGUN WAS HIDDEN WITHOUT THE MAGAZINE. THE MAGAZINE WAS LOCATED IN THE TOP DRAWER ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE BEDROOM WITH ELEVEN ROUNDS OF .45 CALIBER BULLETS. FOR SAFE KEEPING AND BOTH JOAQUIN AND [REDACTED] SAFETY, R/O TOOK THE HANDGUN ALONG WITH THE MAGAZINE/BULLETS AND PLACED THEM INTO EVIDENCE FOR SAFE KEEPING.

WHEN OFFICERS ESCORTED [REDACTED] TO HER VEHICLE, A GRAY GMC PICK-UP PULLED INTO THE [REDACTED] PARKING LOT ON THE EAST SIDE. AFTER THE DRIVER WHO WAS IDENTIFIED AS JOAQUIN, PARKED THE VEHICLE ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE PARKING LOT, R/O ADVISED JOAQUIN TO STEP OUT OF THE VEHICLE WITH HIS HANDS SHOWING AT WHICH TIME HE COMPLIED. FOR OFFICERS SAFETY, R/O PATTED DOWN JOAQUIN FOR WEAPONS. WHILE SPEAKING WITH JOAQUIN, R/O SMELLED A STRONG ODOR OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE EMANATING FROM HIS PERSONS. JOAQUIN ALSO HAD BLOOD SHOT GLASSY RED EYES. WHEN R/O ASKED JOAQUIN WHAT HAD HAPPENED WITH HIM AND HIS WIFE, JOAQUIN IMMEDIATELY ASKED OFFICERS IF HIS WIFE CALLED THE POLICE. FOR THE SAFETY OF THE VICTIM AND THREATS MADE TO HER, R/O ADVISED JOAQUIN THAT OFFICERS RECEIVED A LOUD NOISE COMPLAINT COMING FROM HIS APARTMENT. WHEN R/O ASKED AGAIN WHAT HAD HAPPENED WITH HIM AND HIS WIFE, HE STATED THEY WERE VERBALLY ARGUING. WHEN R/O ASKED HIM WHERE HE HAD GONE, HE STATED HE WAS BEHIND THE APARTMENT COMPLEX THE WHOLE TIME. WHEN R/O ASKED JOAQUIN IF HE STRUCK OR TOUCHED HIS

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WIFE, HE STATED HE DID NOT. WHEN HE WAS ASKED IF HE MADE ANY THREATS TOWARDS HER, HE STATED HE DID NOT.

R/O PLACED JOAQUIN UNDER ARREST FOR DOMESTIC BATTERY. HE WAS HANDCUFFED, CHECKED FOR SNUGNESS, DOUBLE-LOCKED, SEARCHED, AND PLACED IN THE REAR PASSENGER SIDE SEAT OF OFC. MIRANDOLA'S SQUAD CAR WHERE HE WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE BENSENVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT (BPD). UPON ARRIVAL AT BPD, JOAQUIN WAS BOOKED, AND PROCESSED. WHILE IN BOOKING, JOAQUIN ASKED OFFICERS MULTIPLE TIMES IF HIS WIFE HAD CALLED THE POLICE ON HIM SHOWING SIGNS OF ANGER. R/O ADVISED JOAQUIN EXACTLY WHAT HE WAS TOLD BEFORE AT THE APARTMENT. OFC. CASILLAS #555 TRANSPORTED JOAQUIN TO DUPAGE COUNTY JAIL AWAITING BOND. JOAQUIN WAS CHARGED WITH TWO COUNTS OF DOMESTIC BATTERY.

R/O SPOKE WITH BESSIE FROM VICTIM'S ADVOCACY REGARDING THE INCIDENT.

NOTHING FUTHER AT THIS TIME.
