I am pleased to help you with your December 2, 2016 Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"). Your request was received by the Village of Bensenville on December 2, 2016. You requested copies of the items indicated below:

After a search of Village files, the following documents are enclosed to fulfill your request:

These are all of the documents that can be discovered responsive to your request.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provided that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when complied without possibility of attribution to any person." 5ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion per person privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/9, I am required to advise you that I, the undersigned Freedom of Information Officer, reviewed and in consultation with an attorney for the Village, made the foregoing determination to deny a portion of your FOIA Request as indicated. Should you believe that this Response constitutes an improper denial of your request, you may appeal such by filing a request for review within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter with the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Public Access Bureau, 500 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; telephone 1-887-299-FOIA; e-mail: [publicaccess@atg.state.il.us](mailto:publicaccess@atg.state.il.us). You may also have a right of judicial review of the denial under Section 11 of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/11.

Report Narrative: **On 11/25/2016 at about 0040 hours Reporting Officer Herrera (R/O) was dispatched to [REDACTED] for a residential burglary report.**

R/O arrived on scene and met with the victim Yuridia Cruz-Campos (FW [REDACTED]). Inside apartment [REDACTED] R/O observed the inside of the apartment in complete disarray. All the furniture was found completely broken with shattered glass on the living room floor. The living room flat screen television was also damaged with dents on the screen. An aluminum bat was found on the floor next to the television. Also found broken in the living room was a vacuum cleaner, workout equipment, a lamp, books, photograph frames and other living room items. Yuridia said that she did not find any missing items and her bedrooms did not appear disturbed. All of the broken items inside the apartment belong to Yuridia or her family and nothing that wasn't in the apartment was found inside.

Yuridia said that on 11/25/2016 at 1900 hours she left the apartment with her family. Her father stayed inside the apartment at that time. Yuridia said her father comes and leaves the apartment at random and does not believe he was home when the burglary occurred. Yuridia was unable to communicate with her father while R/O was on scene. Yuridia said she did not lock the apartment door when she left with her family. When she arrived at around midnight the apartment door was found opened. Yuridia did not have any suspects.

R/O knocked on the neighbors doors and initially made contact with the resident in apartment [REDACTED]. The neighbor in apartment [REDACTED] did not wish to identify himself but said the neighbors above him in apartment [REDACTED] have been drinking all day, being loud and running around the apartment disturbing his family. He suspected the residence in apartment [REDACTED] were involved in the burglary. He stated about 6 male Hispanic subjects live in that apartment.

R/O then made contact with Anna Mendez (MW [REDACTED]) who lives in apartment [REDACTED]. She said that around 1900 hours she heard very loud noises coming from the upstairs apartment, [REDACTED]. She said it sound like things were being thrown to the ground and glass was breaking. She called 911 to report the incident, BV16012105. Anna stated the noises continued for about 30 minutes until Bensenville Police Officers arrived on scene. Anna said that when the Officer's knocked on the door a foot steps were heard of a person running towards the rear northwest corner of the apartment toward a bedroom. It then became silent. After Officers were unable to make contact with the tenants in apartment [REDACTED] they left the scene. Anna said that she then heard the footsteps move toward then rear north side door. She then heard the subject run down the stairs and exit the apartment building. Anna was certain the subject exited the building because the door slams loudly when exiting the building via the rear north door. Anna further said the landlord, Mike, has high tech cameras which would of captured somebody exiting the building. Anna said she never did see the person who committed the burglary but suspects the tenants in apartment [REDACTED] due to their loud parties and drunkenness. Anna said 6-10 male Hipanic subjects of Guatamelen decent live in apartment [REDACTED]. Anna was unable to provide any names of the tenants. She said they moved in about 2-3 months ago. Anna provide R/O with the telephone number of the landlord who would be able to provide the video recording of the apartment complex, ([REDACTED]).

R/O spoke to Yuridia again and asked her about the tenants in apartment [REDACTED]. Yuridia appeared hesitant to suspect the tenants in [REDACTED]. She said was aware of the 6-7 male subjects living their and they drunken activities. She said doesn't know any of the males and would not know why they would enter her apartment and cause such extensive damage. R/O provided Yuridia with a business card and advised her to contact R/O or the police department if she finds anything missing.

R/O was unable to make contact with the landlord Mike at the this time.
