## UNIFORM DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

The services provided to you by **MC Squared Energy Services** are governed by the Power Supply Agreement and Terms and Conditions of Service with the Village of Bensenville. Below is a summary of some of the important details about your switch to MC Squared Energy Services.

<b>Retail Electric Supplier (RES)</b>	Electricity supply services will be provided by <b>MC Squared Energy Services, LLC</b> (“MC Squared” or “mc <sup>2</sup> ”).
<b>Business Address</b>	175 West Jackson, Suite 240, Chicago, IL 60604
<b>Service Offer</b>	Electricity supply services for your residence or small business.
<b>MC Squared Charges</b>	<p>The fixed mc<sup>2</sup> price is 7.19 cents per kWh through September 2019 meter read cycle.</p> <p>Starting June 1, 2018 and for the remainder of the term, the price will be the lesser of: (1) 7.19 cents per kWh or (2) the ComEd Purchased Electricity Charges (annualized summer/non-summer) and Transmission Charges minus 0.1 cents per kWh, without taking into account the ComEd Purchased Electricity Adjustment (PEA). Reference the Terms and Conditions of Service for additional information.</p>
<b>Term of Agreement</b>	The term of the agreement will begin with the first billing cycle your rate change is confirmed with ComEd and continue through your September 2019 meter read cycle date.
<b>Renewal Policy</b>	Unless this Agreement and/or the PSA is terminated prior to the end of the term of this Agreement and in the event the PSA is not renewed or extended by the Village, you will be restored to tariffed service at the end of the term of this Agreement. If the PSA is renewed or extended by the Village, you will receive a notice with the proposed specific rate, terms and conditions and the opportunity to opt-out of the Village’s Aggregation Program.

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<b>Early Termination Fee</b>	There are <b>NO Termination Fees</b> if you terminate the MC Squared Agreement prior to the end of the applicable term. If you terminate your agreement early, you will be obligated to pay for services rendered under the contract until service is terminated.
<b>Deposit</b>	mc <sup>2</sup> does not require a deposit for its service. ComEd, however, may require a deposit for its service, and will inform you of any such requirement.
<b>Switching Fee</b>	mc <sup>2</sup> does not assess any fee to you for switching to mc <sup>2</sup> .
<b>Rescission Process</b>	You may rescind your agreement with mc <sup>2</sup> prior to enrollment with ComEd. You can also rescind your agreement and the pending enrollment with ComEd, within ten (10) days after you receive the enrollment notice from ComEd by contacting mc <sup>2</sup> at 1-855-724-6294 or by contacting ComEd at 1-800-Edison1.
<b>Electric Reliability</b>	ComEd will continue to be responsible for the delivery of power to your residence and will continue to respond to service calls and emergencies. Switching to mc <sup>2</sup> will not impact your electric service reliability.
<b>Sales Agents</b>	mc <sup>2</sup> is an independent seller of power and energy services and has been certified by the Illinois Commerce Commission. mc <sup>2</sup> sales agents do not represent or act on behalf of your electric distribution service provider (ComEd), any governmental bodies nor consumer groups.
<b>Customer Choice</b>	You may purchase electricity supply from a Retail Electricity Supplier (RES) or ComEd (either fixed price or hourly service). <b>Net Metering Customers</b>	If you are currently enrolled as a net metering customer, you may forfeit credits for electric supply services and delivery services, or both, if you switch from your current electricity supplier to participate in this program.
