**PROJECT INFORMATION LETTER NO. 2**

**CRESTBROOK SUBDIVISION ROADWAY  
RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT**

Dear Resident:

This week, the Contractor will be moving into the first major phase of construction on the Crestbrook Reconstruction Project. Beginning on Tuesday June 13, the contractor will be excavating for the installation of the concrete ribbon on the inside of the Woodland, Center, Forestview, Addison loop. During this work, the contractor will be removing part of the roadway pavement across your driveway apron. Also, a portion of your driveway apron which is in the roadway right-of-way will be removed. The period of inaccessibility is anticipated to be a few hours, and the contractor will knock on doors prior to removing access. Once the pavement and apron removal are completed this week, the contractor will be providing stone to allow for driveway access for the remainder of this week.

Next week, the contractor is planning to install the new concrete ribbon by means of a slip form paving machine. It is during this work that we will need to close your apron for up to 7 days to allow time for the concrete to cure. A separate, orange construction notice will be delivered to your front door letting you know which day this work will take place and where to park any vehicles you may need.

The Village is continuing to coordinate with Republic Services and the USPS with regards to this project. There are no changes planned at this time. Please continue to place your trash bins at the curb by 5AM on Wednesday mornings to ensure your trash is picked up.

We thank you for your patience and cooperation during this project. During the work, if you have urgent questions, please contact the Resident Engineer below. He is the fastest way to get an answer as he is on site while the work is happening.
