PROJECT INFORMATION LETTER NO. 4 CRESTBROOK SUBDIVISION ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Dear Resident:

As July comes to a close, we are pleased to let you know that all the ribbon curbs have been installed and driveway pavements are also completed. All driveways are open and you are no longer required to park on the roadway overnight. We would like to sincerely thank you for your cooperation with the concrete work over the past month!

Next week, RW Dunteman will be moving into the final major phase of construction on the Crestbrook Reconstruction Project. Removal of the existing roadway asphalt and excavation for a new, thicker 8" asphalt pavement will begin on Monday July 31. Vehicles will be traveling on the stone roadway base during this phase of work and stone ramps will be utilized to maintain access to driveways. There will be short-term inaccessibility as the pavement removal operation passes your driveway, but the contractor will be placing the stone ramp as soon as possible following the grinding machine.

Additionally, during this process we will need to establish a one-way traffic flow around the loop of streets in the neighborhood. There is simply not enough room to allow for the pavement removal operation while keeping two-way traffic. The contractor will be erecting "One-Way" and "Do Not Enter" signs as a reminder for residents follow this temporary traffic pattern. Weather permitting, we anticipate the new roadway pavement will be installed in about 10 days.

Lastly, we are asking everyone to park all vehicles in your driveway during working hours until the new pavement can be installed. This will allow the removal of the existing pavement and installation of the new pavement to progress as quick as possible. The Village is continuing to coordinate with Republic Services and there are no changes planned at this time. Please continue to place your trash bins at the curb by 5AM Wednesday mornings to ensure your trash is picked up. Mailboxes that were relocated during the concrete work will be reinstalled to their original location following the completion of the pavement installation.

We thank you for your patience and cooperation during this project. During the work, if you have urgent questions, please contact the Resident Engineer below. He is the fastest way to get an answer as he is on site while the work is happening.
